# INTRODUCTION



The Psalms are the ancient hymnal of the people of Israel. They are a collection of the songs that the Israelites expressed their heart of worship before their God and Creator. There are a variety of psalms, or songs, that can largely be categorized. Some of the categories can be described as songs of praise, songs of lament, royal songs and songs of thanksgiving.

One specific category of songs are referred to as the “Hallelujah Psalms.” The word Hallelujah means, “Praise the Lord,” so these Psalms are a collection of a heart that desires to call others to Praise the Lord. There are four sections of “Hallelujah Psalms” and during the month of January we are wanting to call our body to a month of praise. 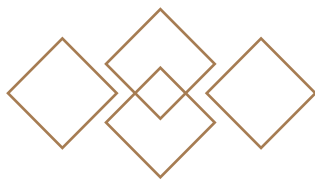

Psalm 105:1-4



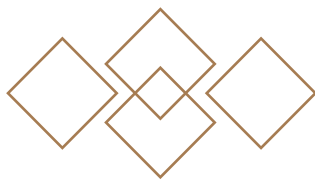
## PROMPT

Psalm 105:5-7



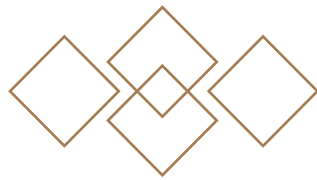
PROMPT

Psalm 105:8-11



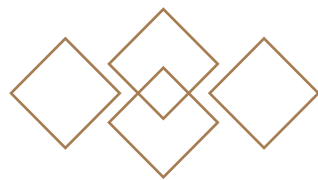
PROMPT

Psalm 105:12-15



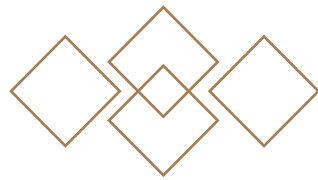
PROMPT

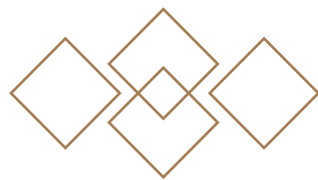
Praise! Praise the Lord for His sovereign plan

Psalm 105:23-38



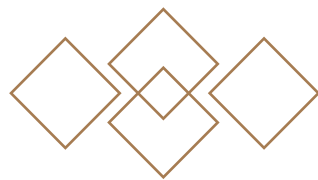
PROMPT

Psalm 105:39-45



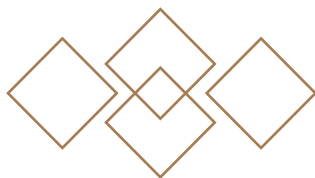
PROMPT

Psalm 106:1-12



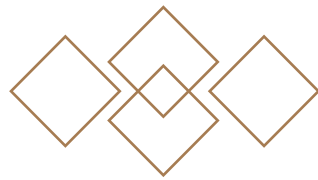
PROMPT

Psalm 106:13-23



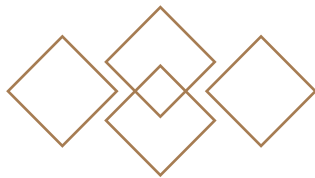
PROMPT

Psalm 106:24-27



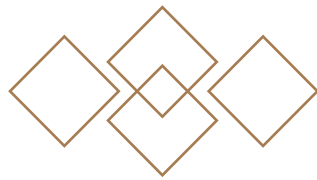
PROMPT

Psalm 106:28-33



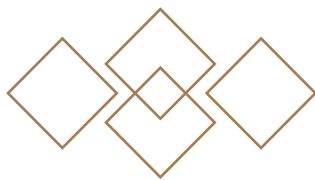
PROMPT

Psalm 106:34-39



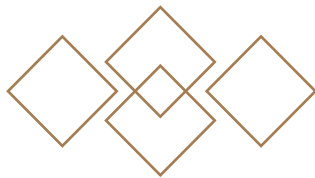
PROMPT

PROMPT

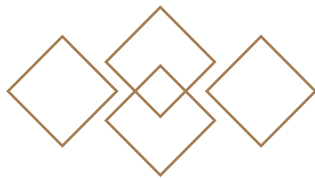
Praise! Praise the Lord for reproof and rebuking His people by allowing them to undergo judgment.

Praise! Praise the Lord for His salvation of His people! Praise Him for the gathered worship of sinners who have been saved!



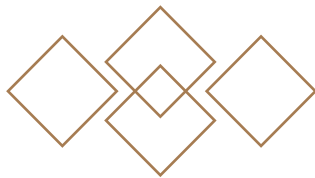

Psalm 111:1-5



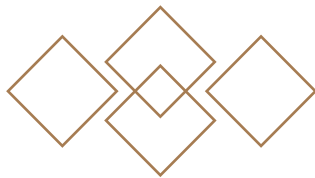
PROMPT

Psalm 111:6-10



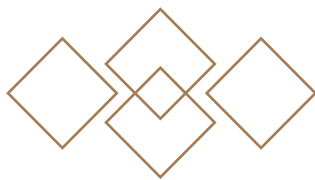
PROMPT

Psalm 112:1-5



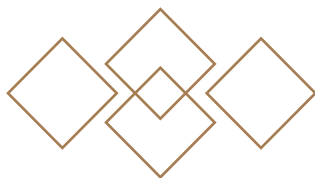
PROMPT

Psalm 112:6-10



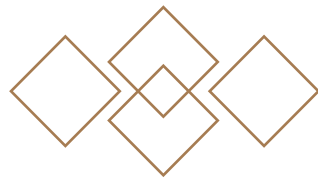
PROMPT

Psalm 113:1-9



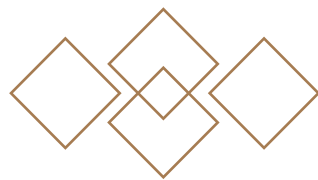

PROMPT

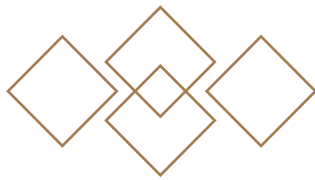
Praise! Praise the Lord for His love for the

Psalm 118:1-7



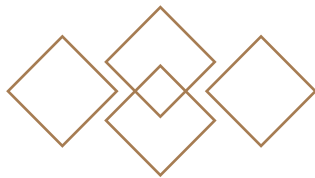
PROMPT

Psalm 118:8-14



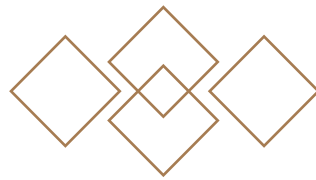
PROMPT

Psalm 118:15-21



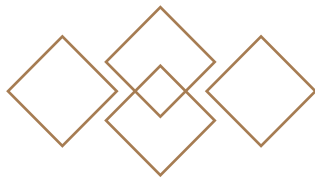
PROMPT

success!



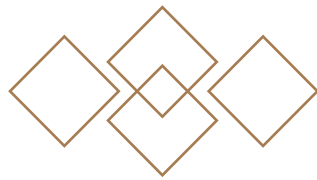

Psalm 134



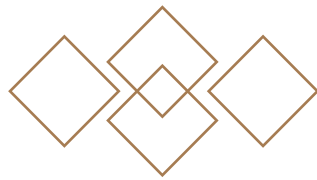
PROMPT

Psalm 135:1-7



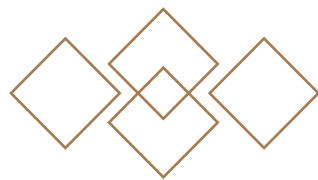
PROMPT

PROMPT

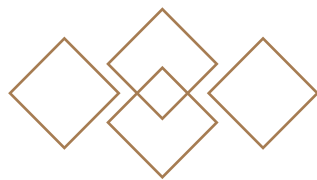
Praise! Praise the Lord for His deliverance of His people! Note how often and significant the Israelites were praising God for their deliverance and salvation!

Psalm 135:13-21



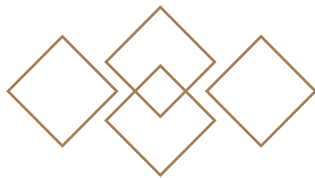
PROMPT

Psalm 136:1-9



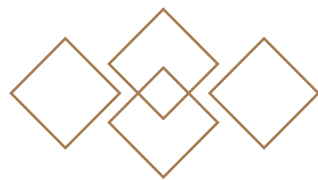
PROMPT

Psalm 136:10-22



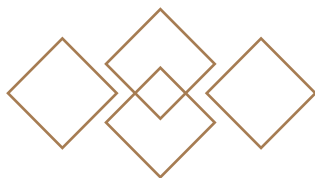
PROMPT
