Dear Friends,

Ezekiel 37 (in the Old Testament) contains this stunning promise from the Father: *“I will put my Spirit within you.”* For centuries the Hebrew people had waited, and waited, and waited, for the Father to fulfill this promise.

Fifty days after Jesus rose from the dead, that promise was kept. We’ll hear about that moment in our reading from Acts: when fire descended and the Holy Spirit was no longer a force *external* to Israel, but *internal* to each Jesus follower.

The Holy Spirit is the key. It’s the key to hearing God’s guidance, receiving His strength, doing His work, building genuine community, experiencing God’s forgiveness, and feeling Jesus’ presence in your life. I wish someone had explained it this simply to me as a teenager. The even more remarkable bit is that God wants to pour more and more of the Holy Spirit into you. I pray you’ll continue to receive that blessing today.

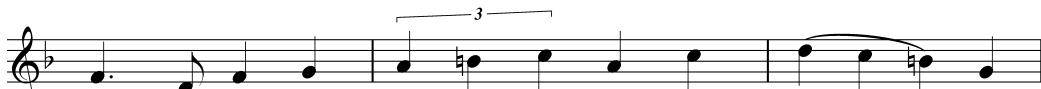

Holy Scripture:

(1) **Numbers 11:24-30**

Moses went out and told the people the words of the LORD; and he gathered seventy elders of the people, and placed them all around the tent. ²⁵Then the LORD came down in the cloud and spoke to him, and took some of the spirit that was on him and put it on the seventy elders; and when the spirit rested upon them, they prophesied. But they did not do so again.

²⁶Two men remained in the camp, one named Eldad, and the other named Medad, and the

spirit rested on them; they were among those registered, but they had not gone out to the tent, and so they prophesied in the camp. ²⁷ And a young man ran and told Moses, ‘Eldad and Medad are prophesying in the camp.’ ²⁸ And Joshua son of Nun, the assistant of Moses, one of his chosen men, said, ‘My lord Moses, stop them!’ ²⁹ But Moses said to him, ‘Are you jealous for my sake? Would that all the LORD’S people were prophets, and that the LORD would put his spirit on them!’ ³⁰ And Moses and the elders of Israel returned to the camp.

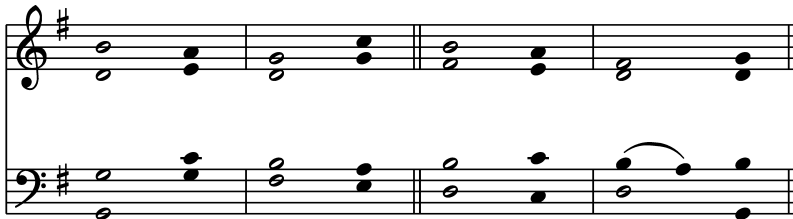

(3) **1 Corinthians 12:3b-13**

No one can say ‘Jesus is Lord’ except by the Holy Spirit. ⁴Now there are varieties of gifts, but the same Spirit; ⁵and there are varieties of services, but the same Lord; ⁶and there are varieties of activities, but it is the same God who activates all of them in everyone. ⁷To each is given the manifestation of the Spirit for the common good. ⁸To one is given through the Spirit the utterance of wisdom, and to another the utterance of knowledge according to the same Spirit, ⁹to another faith by the same Spirit, to another gifts of healing by the one Spirit, ¹⁰to another the working of miracles, to another prophecy, to another the discernment of spirits, to another various kinds of tongues, to another the interpretation of tongues. ¹¹All these are activated by one and the same Spirit, who allots to each one individually just as the Spirit chooses. ¹²For just as the body is one and has many members, and all the members of the body, though many, are one body, so it is with Christ. ¹³For in the one Spirit we were all baptized into one body—Jews or Greeks, slaves or free—and we were all made to drink of one Spirit.
