

Sermon Notes 07/12/26 – Genesis 22

Another mountain rears its head, Moriah! Abraham and Isaac stood upon a spiritual plateau, higher than ever reached by man before. But there is one higher - Mount Calvary!

The message of Mount Moriah is really the Message of the Messiah.

Moriah - means foreseen of God or a foreshadow of things to come!

Genesis 22:1-2 - God tests Abraham - Was his confidence in his son, Isaac, or in God who gave him his son?

Genesis 22 shows us what Calvary meant to the Father! Read *Psalm 69, Isaiah 53, Psalm 22* - to see what Calvary meant to the Son.

How was Abraham able to carry this out? (*Genesis 22:5, Hebrews 11:17-19*)

Abraham risked everything he owned and loved upon the character of God and found him to be a God of Resurrection. (*Genesis 22:6-12*)

It was a word of Prophecy for 2000 years, later on that same mountain God would provide Himself a lamb. The LAMB. (*Genesis 22:13-19*)

Where does the Lord provide our needs? In the place of His assignment!

Weekly Memory Verse:

Genesis 22:14 – Abraham called the name of that place the LORD Will Provide, as it is said to this day, In the mount of the LORD it will be provided.
