

Sermon Notes 08/09/26 – Hebrews 11:5-6, Genesis 5:21-24

It takes faith to walk with God

- I. The first step is a step of Faith.

Where did Enoch get that faith? We never have faith until we hear from God! (*Romans 10:17*) Enoch was a prophet. (*Jude 14*)

- II. Fellowship – to walk with God is a figure of the most intimate fellowship with God. (*Micah 6:8, Amos 3:3*)

- III. Faithfulness. Enoch did not walk with God in an easy time. Because of man's wickedness, God is preparing to destroy the world. (*Genesis 5:22, Matthew 24:37*)

- IV. Productivity – Enoch's testimony was pleasing to God. When God sends judgment, He always sends a warning first. Enoch was a prophet. God informed Enoch that a flood was coming and when his baby died, the flood would come. The flood came when Methuselah died! (*Genesis 7:11*)

Like Enoch, we are waiting on the end of the age. Like Enoch, we are expecting the Rapture! Not a tomb, but a translation!

Weekly Memory Verse:

Matthew 10:28 – Do not fear those who kill the body but are unable to kill the soul; but rather fear Him who is able to destroy both soul and body in hell.
