

Sermon Notes 02/15/26 – Ephesians 6:1-9

Paul's word to children.

Obey has to do with action and Honor has to do with attitude.

Obey is “stand under” or to “listen under.”

To put it plainly, it says to children, “Do whatever your parents say.”

Jesus sets the example.

(Luke 2:51-52, Colossians 3:20, Ephesians 6:2-3)

Notice the Promise connected with this commandment - “that it may go well with you and you may live long on the earth.”

Paul's word to the Fathers. *(Ephesians 6:4)*

Dads are to take the lead in these matters of discipline. *(Proverbs 13:24, Proverbs 22:15, Proverbs 19:18, Proverbs 23:13-14)*

Paul's words to workers. *(Ephesians 6:5-8)*

The Bible doesn't condone slavery but recognized it as a part of that society.

(Colossians 3:17, Colossians 4:1)
