

His Presence Through Worship

Psalm 22:3 *But You are holy, Enthroned in the praises of Israel.*

I am thankful that there is no one-size-fits-all when it comes to worship. The Bible doesn't say you must worship God in a certain way. That's because worship is such a powerful outpouring of our hearts toward the Lord that it can't be limited to words or defined by a song, a shout, or even silence.

I want to remind you that there is one sure way you can entertain the Presence of God and this is by worshiping Him. Spending time with our Heavenly Father is a necessity in your Christian walk. We must seek His Presence on a daily basis.

Jesus said, "**True worshipers will worship in spirit and truth...**" John 4:23 The word "**truth**" here means "*reality, sincerity, accuracy, truthfulness and integrity.*" Here are two things I'd like for you to remember as you worship.

First, God created you to worship Him. Perhaps you've never thought of this, yet God created us to do the one thing He can't do for Himself - worship! Nothing brings pleasure to the heart of our Heavenly Father more than the love and adoration of His children.

Second, Worship can be expressed by anybody, anywhere, at any time. The Samaritan woman in Scripture grew up believing that true worship must be expressed at a sacred mountain called Gerizim, whereas the Jews believed it should be practiced in the temple at Jerusalem.

But Jesus said it wasn't to be confined to church or a particular day of the week. It should come from our hearts on a daily basis whenever and wherever we feel the urge to give Him a praise! So, if you want to be sure that the Presence of God will be felt in your life, then go ahead and worship Him.

The psalmist, in his own unique style, puts it like this... "**Servants of the Lord, praise the name of the Lord! Blessed be the name of the Lord from this time forth and forevermore! From the rising of the sun to its going down the Lord's name is to be praised**" Psalm 113:1-3

So go ahead and bring His Presence into your situation by giving Him a praise!
