

# Truth the Spirit Reveals

**John 16:13 *When the Spirit of truth comes, he will guide you into all truth. He will not speak on his own but will tell you what he has heard. He will tell you about the future.***

**Psa 43:3 *Send out your light and your truth; let them guide me. Let them lead me to your holy mountain, to the place where you live.***

**Eph 1:17-18 *asking God, the glorious Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, to give you spiritual wisdom and insight so that you might grow in your knowledge of God. 18 I pray that your hearts will be flooded with light so that you can understand the confident hope he has given to those he called—his holy people, who are his rich and glorious inheritance.***

Too often, we slowly slide into the normalcy of pretending and stay unaware. With this strange statement, I mean that, as Christ Jesus has resurrected our souls by His grace, we know that light and life come only from Him. We are convinced of this emphatic truth. We've looked elsewhere for life and have been awakened to its emptiness. But sadly, we often return there slowly, sinking into the gray of unintentional motion, conditioned responses, and dull routine.

Holy Spirit, open our eyes!

James, the leader of the Jerusalem church, reminds us that when we lack wisdom, we should ask God for it, who gives generously. In Psalm 43, the Psalmist confesses that God's light and truth are the only reliable leaders, for they lead us to where He is, through His Spirit.

God of Heaven, lead us in Truth with your light and truth!

As we continue into this consecrated season of Prayer and fasting, we are coming together as a church, praying that God would lead us, open our eyes to Truth, and allow us to encounter God's presence, and give us the moving power of His Spirit in a fresh and awakening way. This Prayer is a heartfelt, guttural, straining desire to return and encounter True Reality, God's light, and life. We know that the Holy Spirit has resurrected our souls by Christ's grace and that light and life, along with wisdom and revelation, come only from Him.

## Reflect

- Where have you sensed God giving you Truth that leads to the gift of wisdom and discernment in your life?
- James tells us that God will give us wisdom if we ask. Will you ask Him for wisdom? He promises to give it to you when you ask. And that Wisdom will allow you to encounter His Way, Truth, and Life! (John 14:6)

## Prayer

Lord, open my eyes to encounter your presence more clearly and my ears to hear anything You desire to speak. I pray for a Spirit of truth, wisdom, and revelation so that I might know Jesus more deeply and, with understanding, reveal the hope in His heart for me this year.
