

"Never Alone"

Matthew 28:20

"And be sure of this: I am with you always, even to the end of the age."

Psalm 32:8

"I will guide you along the best pathway for your life. I will advise you and watch over you."

There are moments in life when the path ahead feels unclear—when decisions weigh heavy, seasons change unexpectedly, or loneliness whispers that we are walking alone. Yet Jesus speaks a promise that anchors our hearts: “I am with you always.” Not sometimes. Not only when life is easy. Always.

Matthew 28:20 reminds us that Christ’s presence is not dependent on our strength, our certainty, or our circumstances. His companionship is constant. Whether we are stepping into something new or standing still in uncertainty, He is there—close, attentive, and faithful.

Psalm 32:8 takes this promise even deeper. God does not merely walk beside us; He actively guides us. Today, rest in this truth: you are seen, guided, and watched over. You are never walking alone.
