JOHN 17 - “JESUS PRAYS”

Christ's Prayer over Himself, v1-5

- ▶ John's use of rhetorical language was emphatic in nature. "3rd Person"
- ▶ It was a way to distinguish his human nature from His Divine nature, as He prayed to the Father.

Christ's Prayer over Himself

- ▶ Being the fulfillment of the Very Word of God, Jesus calls Himself, "Son."
- ▶ Jesus was revering the Office of the Son of God.

Christ's Prayer for His Disciples, v6-19

- ▶ Jesus was a Good Shepherd, a Pastor to His flock.
- ▶ The Disciples of Jesus are in the world, but not of the World.

Christ's Prayer for all Believers, v20-22

- ▶ This was His “Living Will” and Testament.
- ▶ That we would also receive His Glory
