

JERUSALEM IN ITS CURRENT STATE:

Small. Broken. Exposed.

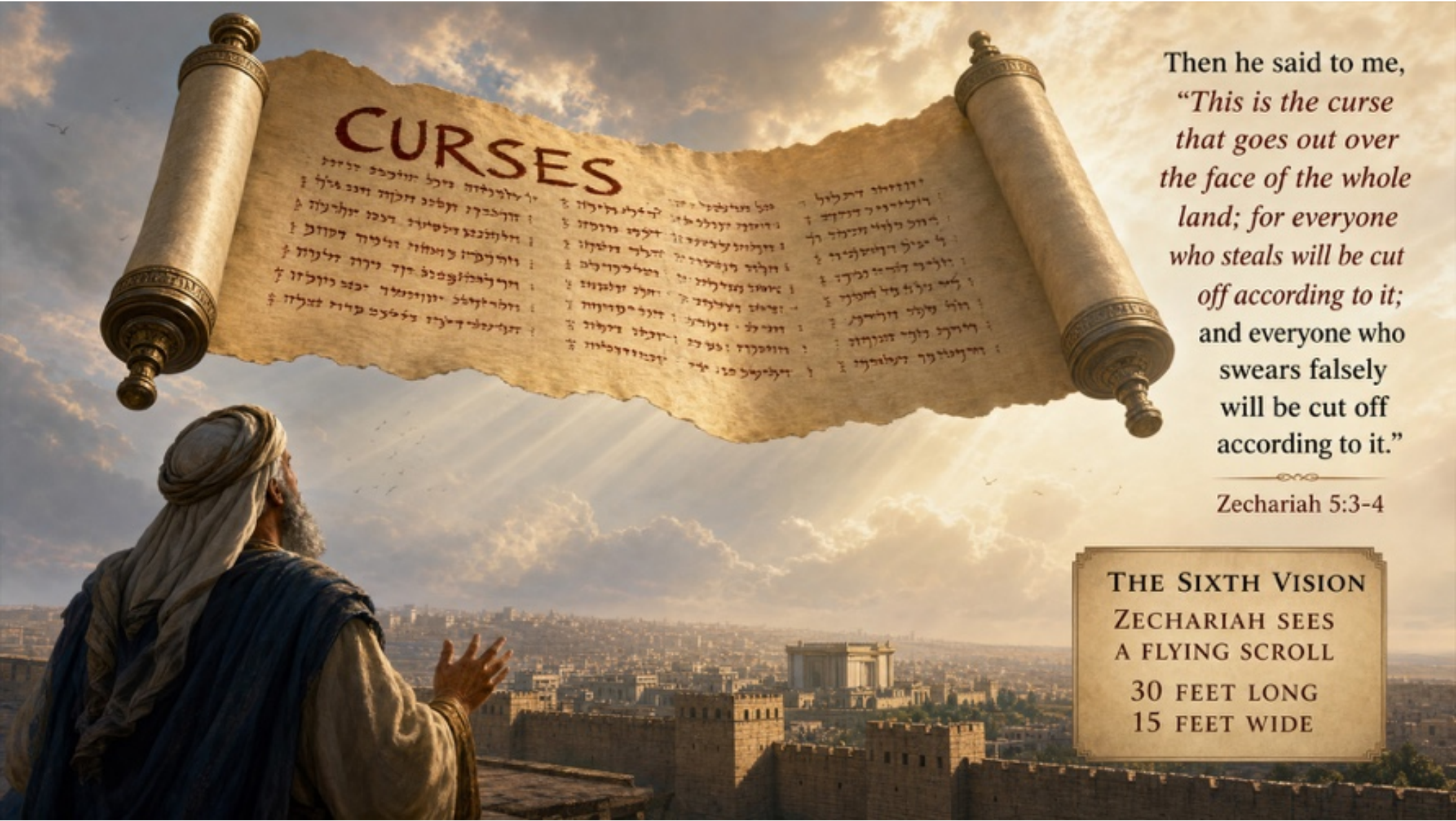
