


UNDERSTANDING OUR WORLD ACCORDING TO GENESIS 1-11

Genesis 1<sup>1</sup> In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth. <sup>2</sup> The earth was without form and void, and darkness was over the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God was hovering over the face of the waters. <sup>2</sup> And God said, "let there be light," and there was light.

While darkness and chaos described the earth, the Spirit of God hovered right above it

God then speaks "light" and it pierces the darkness.

Darkness and chaos always describes a world without God

The Spirit of God always hovers above the darkness and chaos



God is in control

The world God designed is one of order, not chaos, and it is good


God creates humanity as separate from animals and creation, in His own image, and gives us a role in stewarding the world He's created




Genesis 1 <sup>26</sup> Then God said, "Let us make man in our image, after our likeness. And let them have dominion over the fish of the sea and over the birds of the heavens and over the livestock and over all the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth."



Genesis 1<sup>27</sup> So God created man in his own image, in the image of God he created him; male and female he created them.




Genesis 1 <sup>28</sup> And God blessed them. And God said to them, "Be fruitful and multiply and fill the earth and subdue it, and have dominion over the fish of the sea and over the birds of the heavens and over every living thing that moves on the earth."



Genesis 1 <sup>29</sup> And God said, "Behold, I have given you every plant yielding seed that is on the face of all the earth, and every tree with seed in its fruit. You shall have them for food. <sup>30</sup> And to every beast of the earth and to every bird of the heavens and to everything that creeps on the earth, everything that has the breath of life, I have given every green plant for food." And it was so.



Genesis 1 <sup>31</sup> And God saw everything that he had made, and behold, it was very good. And there was evening and there was morning, the sixth day.




Genesis 2 <sup>1</sup> Thus the heavens and the earth were finished, and all the host of them. <sup>2</sup> And on the seventh day God finished his work that he had done, and he rested on the seventh day from all his work that he had done. <sup>3</sup> So God blessed the seventh day and made it holy, because on it God rested from all his work that he had done in creation.



Genesis 2 <sup>5</sup> When no bush of the field was yet in the land and no small plant of the field had yet sprung up – for the Lord God had not caused it to rain on the land, and there was no man to work the ground, <sup>6</sup> and a mist was going up from the land and was watering the whole face of the ground –







Humans are a great contradiction: being formed of the dust of the earth and having God's breath within us

While we can learn a lot about the human body from animals, we cannot derive our morality from them, only from God

Because every human being is made in God's image, each person must be treated with dignity, respect and as our equals

When I get downcast about myself, another person or things that humans do, I remind myself that God's spirit is in them and that he is brooding over them, too
