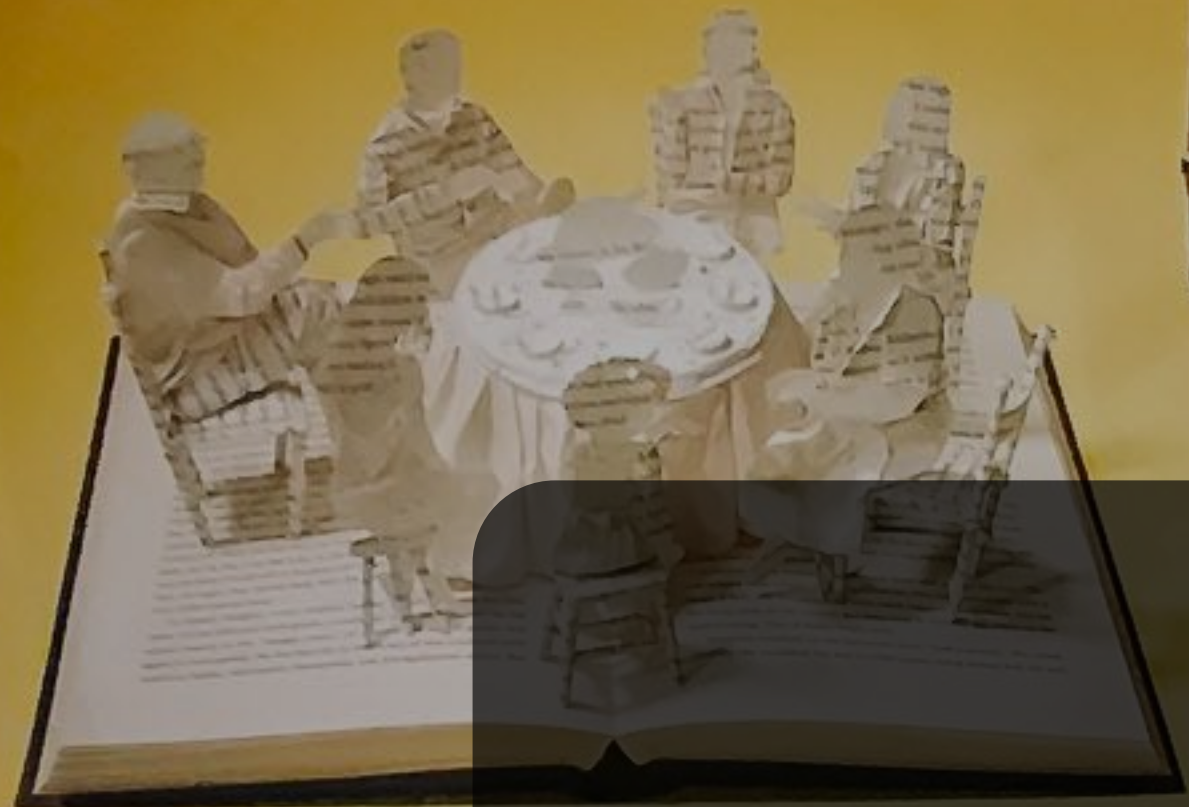
One of the key things that prevents us from being able to make room for others is our own blindness towards others.

Not seeing others the way God sees them.

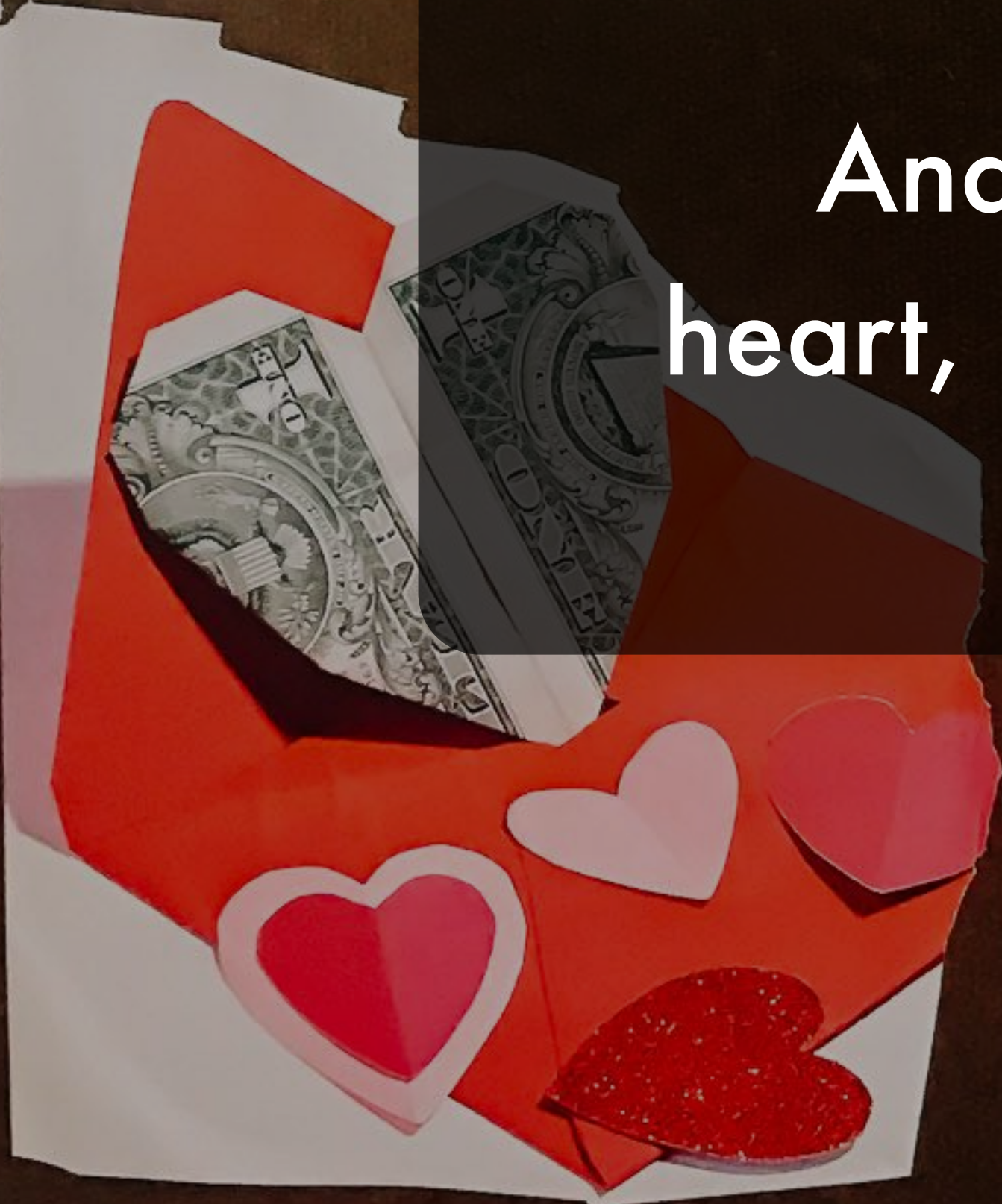




Modern Family
