



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In Genesis, the world was created by the Word of God

while *chronos* marks off general time, *kairos* marks out special time

While *logos* refers to God's eternal Word, *rhema* refers to specific, kairos words from God

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In Genesis, the world was created by the *rhema* Word of God

Today didn't arise from what was visible yesterday, but by God's *rhema* word

Tomorrow will arise not from what is visible today, but by God's *rhema* word

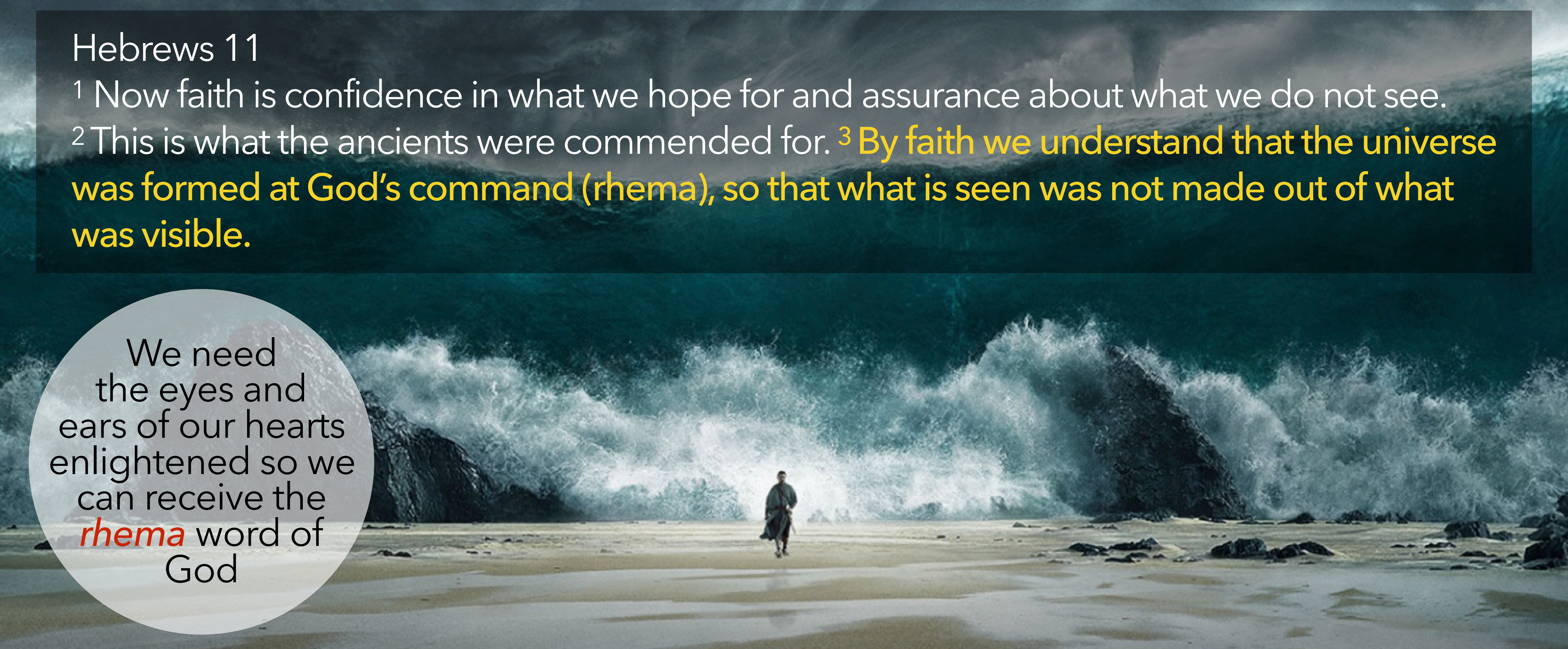
