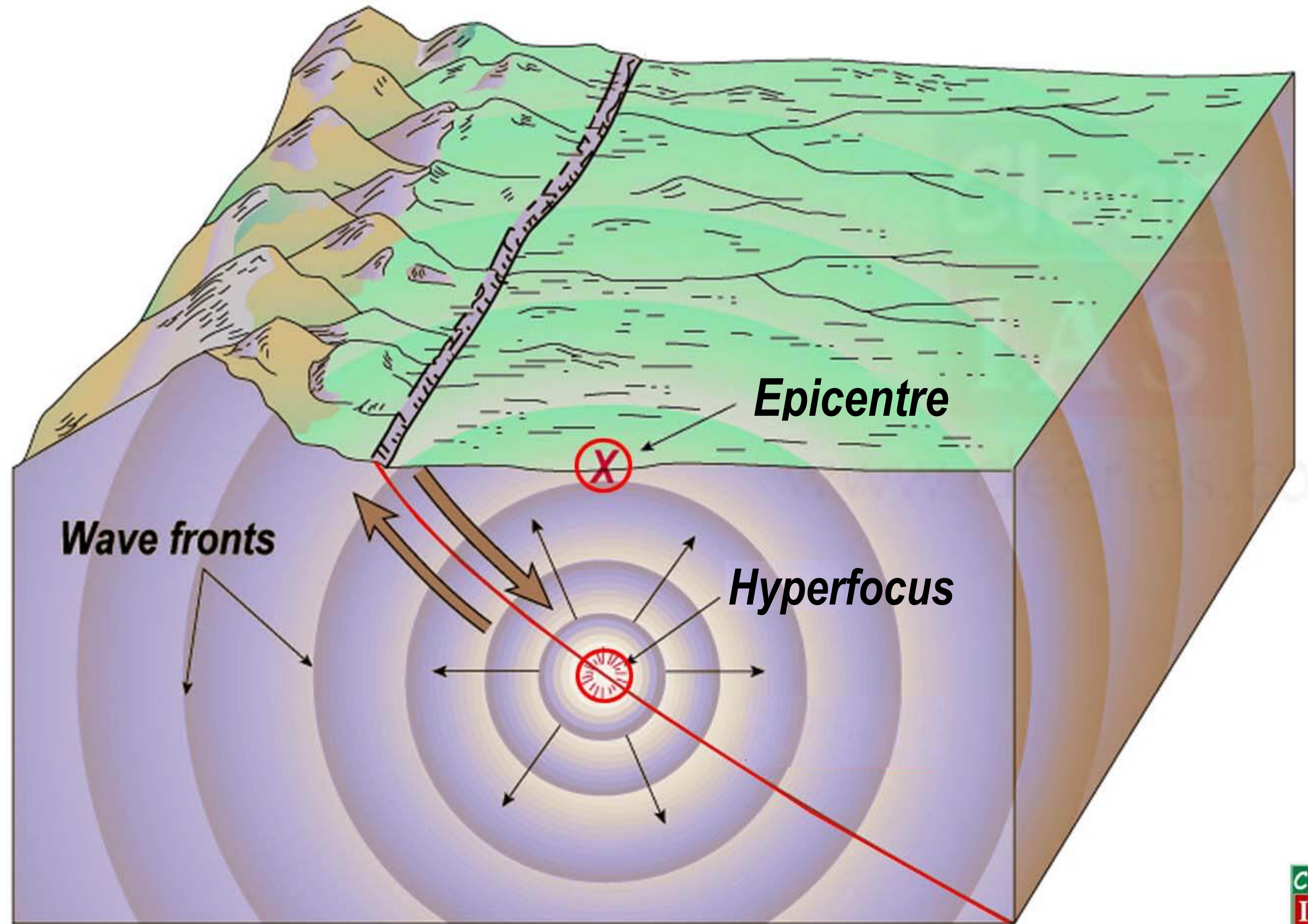

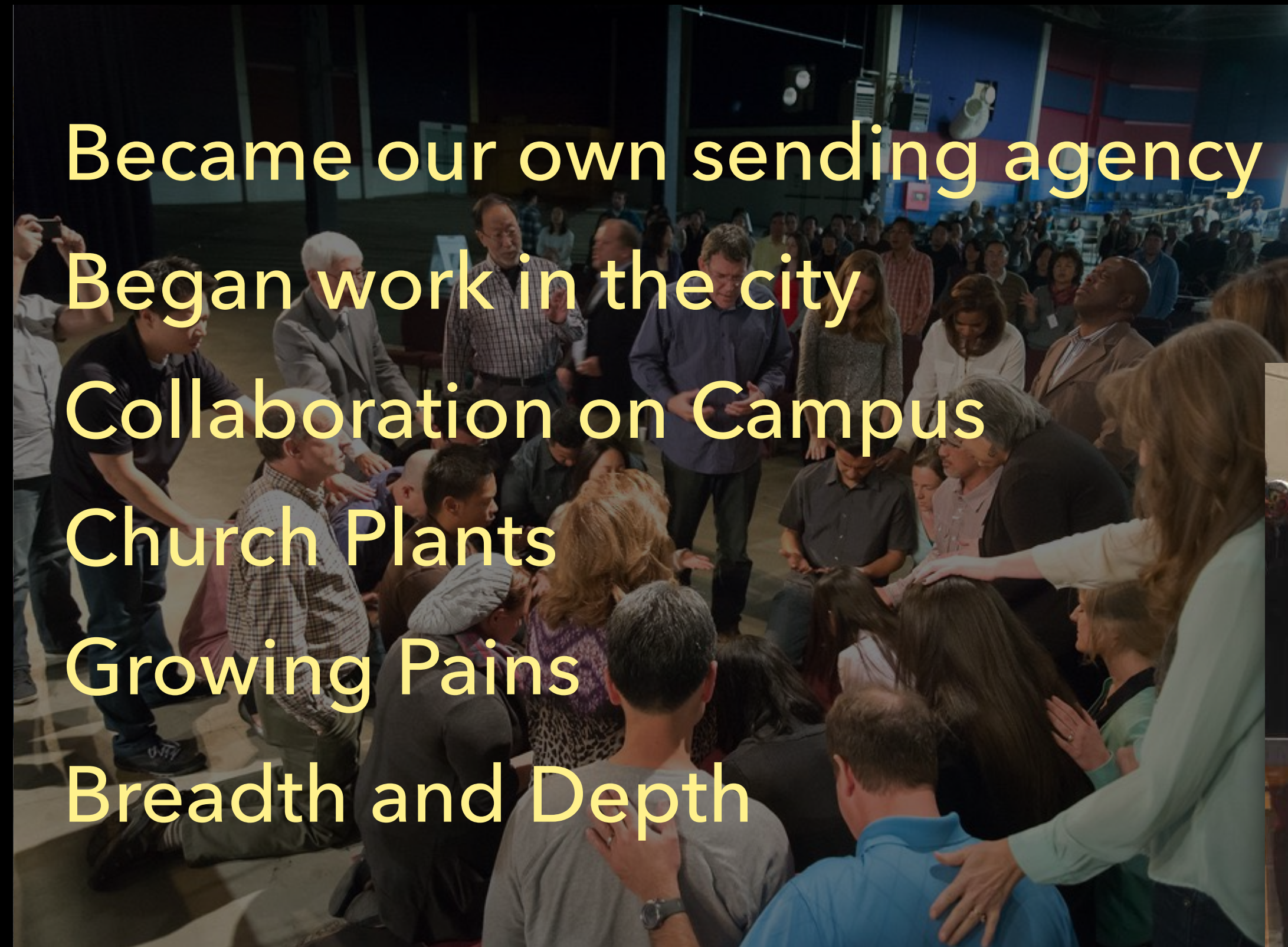



TRUST




I believe that Jesus sees and knows my true self and I re-entrust myself to Him
