Rediscovering the last command of Jesus

Matthew 28:18-20

- 18) Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me.
- 19) Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,
- 20) and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."

19) Therefore go to church, worship, give an offering, listen to a sermon and serve me in whatever way you have time, and whatever way that makes you happy.


4 key actions

all nations = panta ta ethne - panta = all ta ethne = ethnic groups - people groups people who share a common language and culture.

PEOPLE WHO ARE NOT YET DISCIPLES!

EVERYONE is either a disciple or needs to be made a disciple **EVERY DISCIPLE** makes disciples

GO = take the initiative to engage people in conversations in which we communicate who Jesus IS and what He wants to do in their lives.

BAPTIZING = immerse/ submerge in water (as if being buried) and being raised to new life in Him.

TEACHING = training (new disciples) to DO all the things

Jesus commanded us to do!

serve one another remember his death forgive pray

Who me?

"I'm not ... spiritual enough." holy enough." "I don't know enough about the Bible." healthy enough." "I don't know enough about "I'm too young/old." apologetics." "That's not my gift." "I'm not that good at learning "I have a job ... and a life." a new language."
