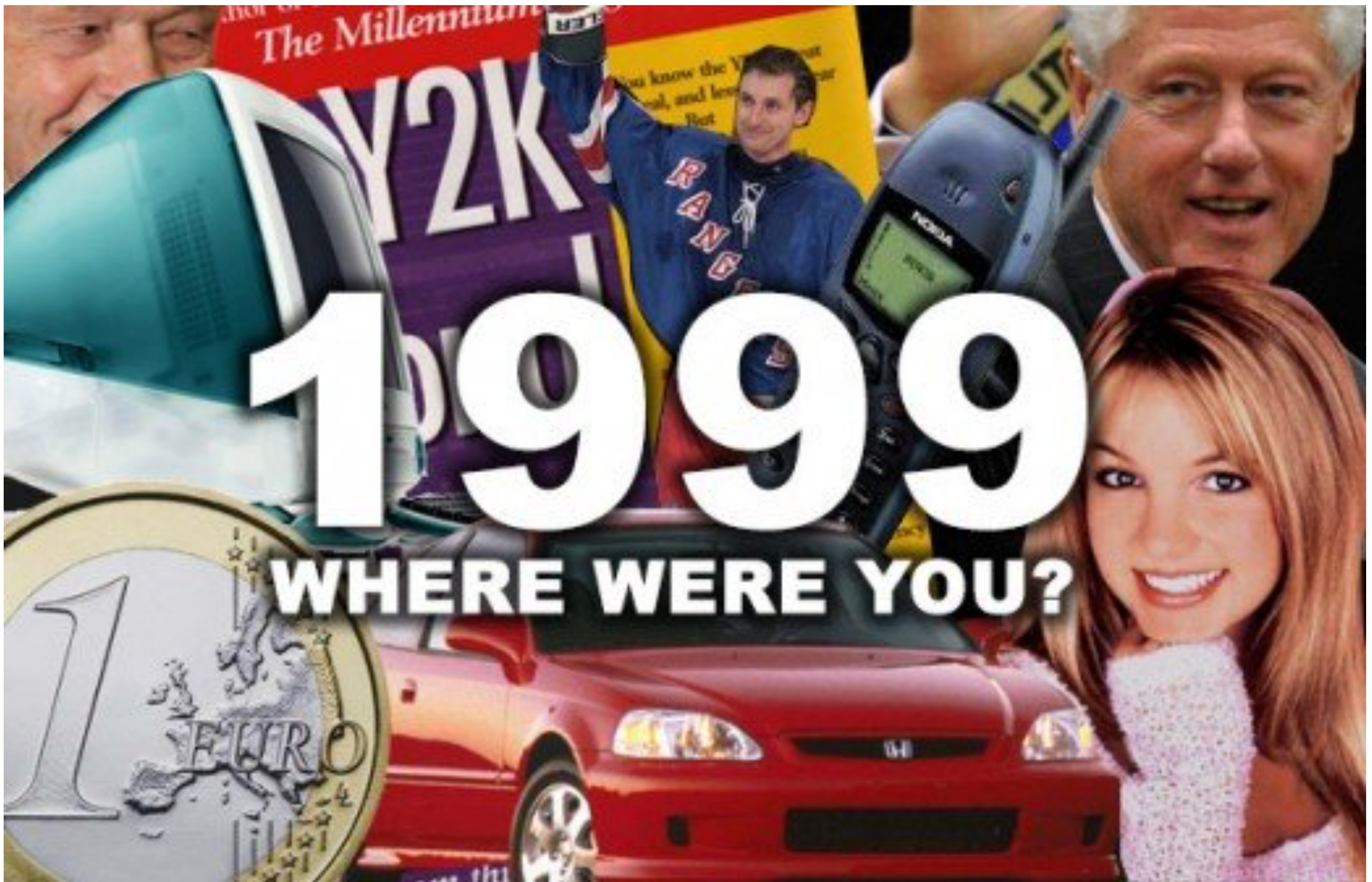

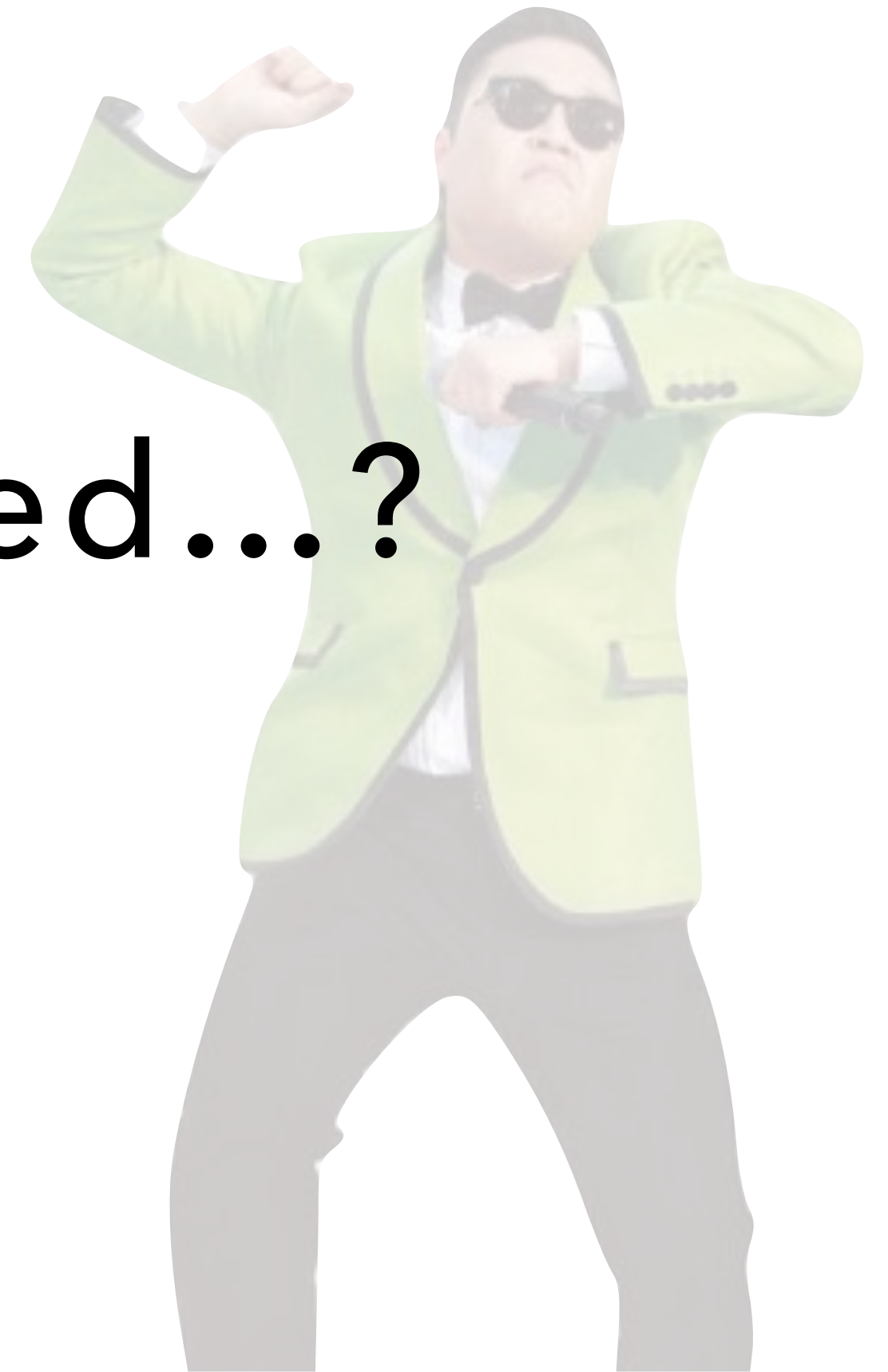

Quickening of life and post-truth information overload

Outsized Problems
