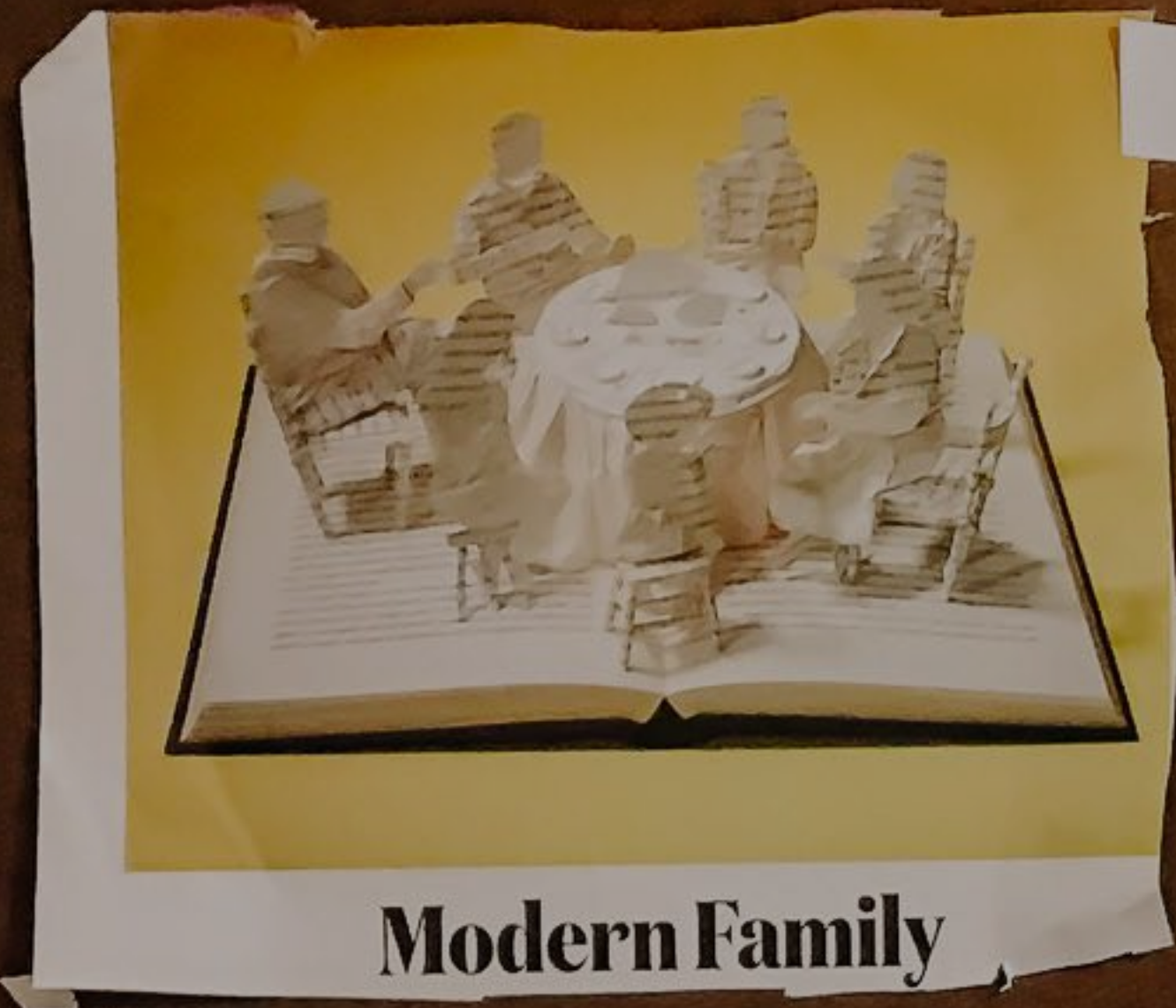


What does making room in your heart for Jesus mean?

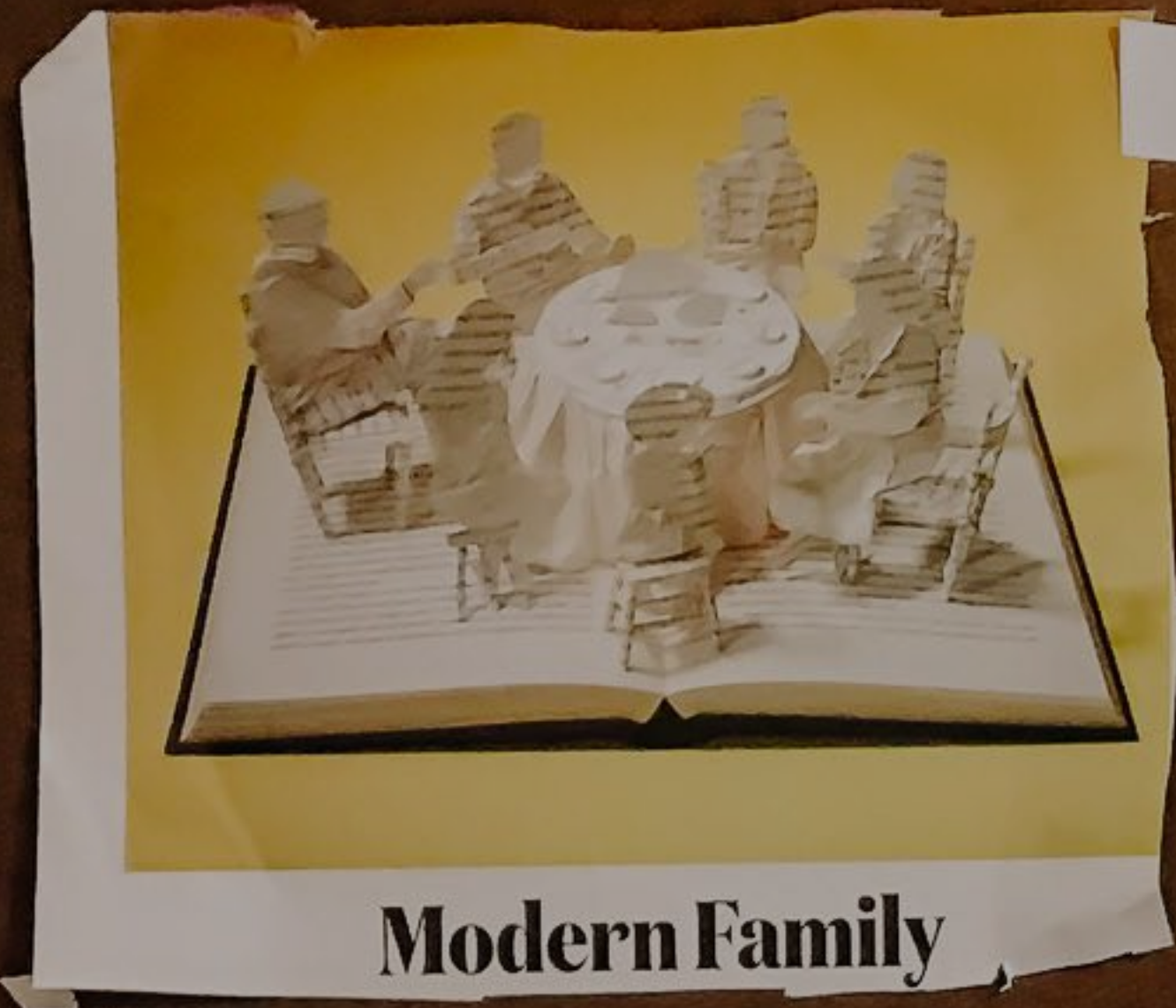


What does making room in your heart for Jesus mean?

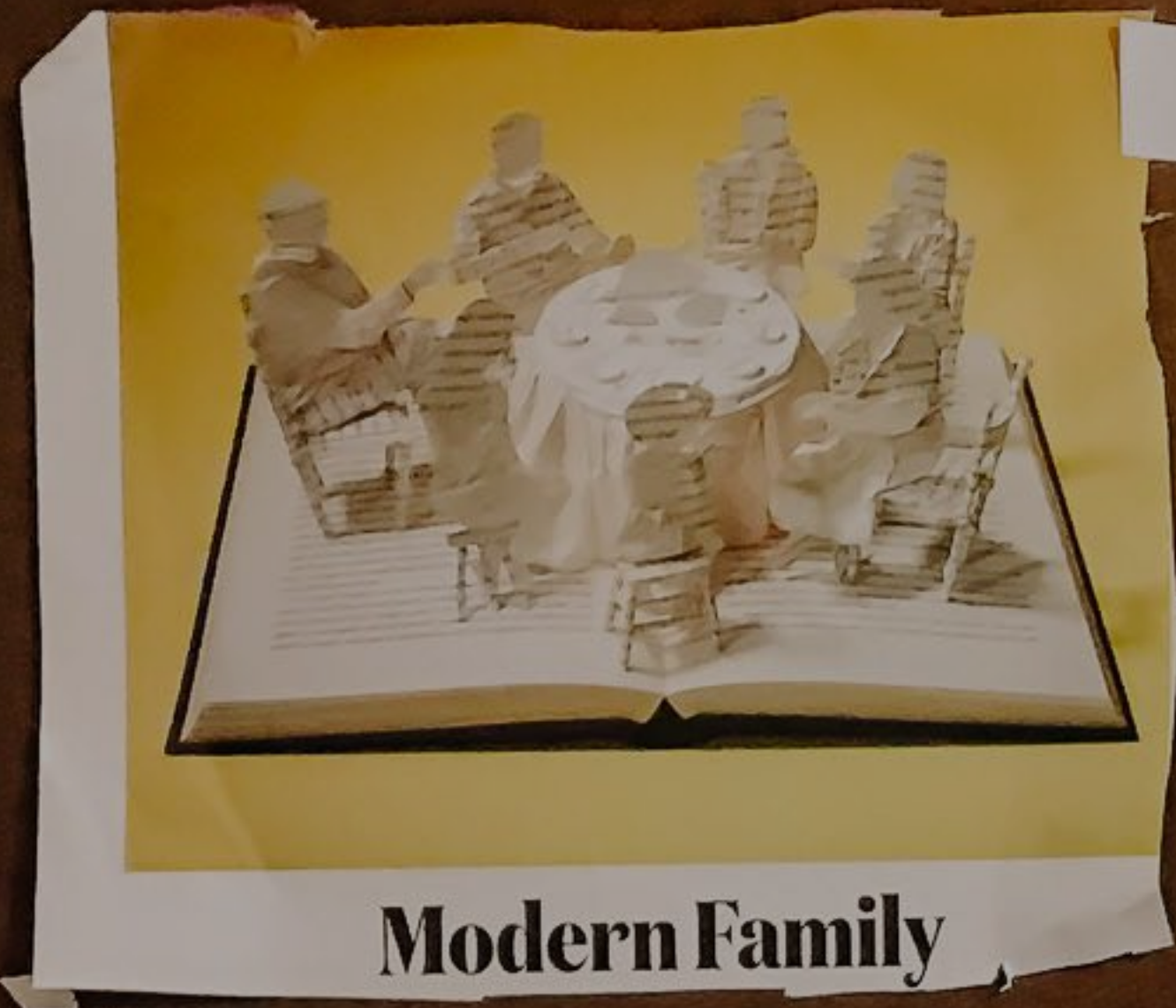


What does making room in your heart for Jesus mean?

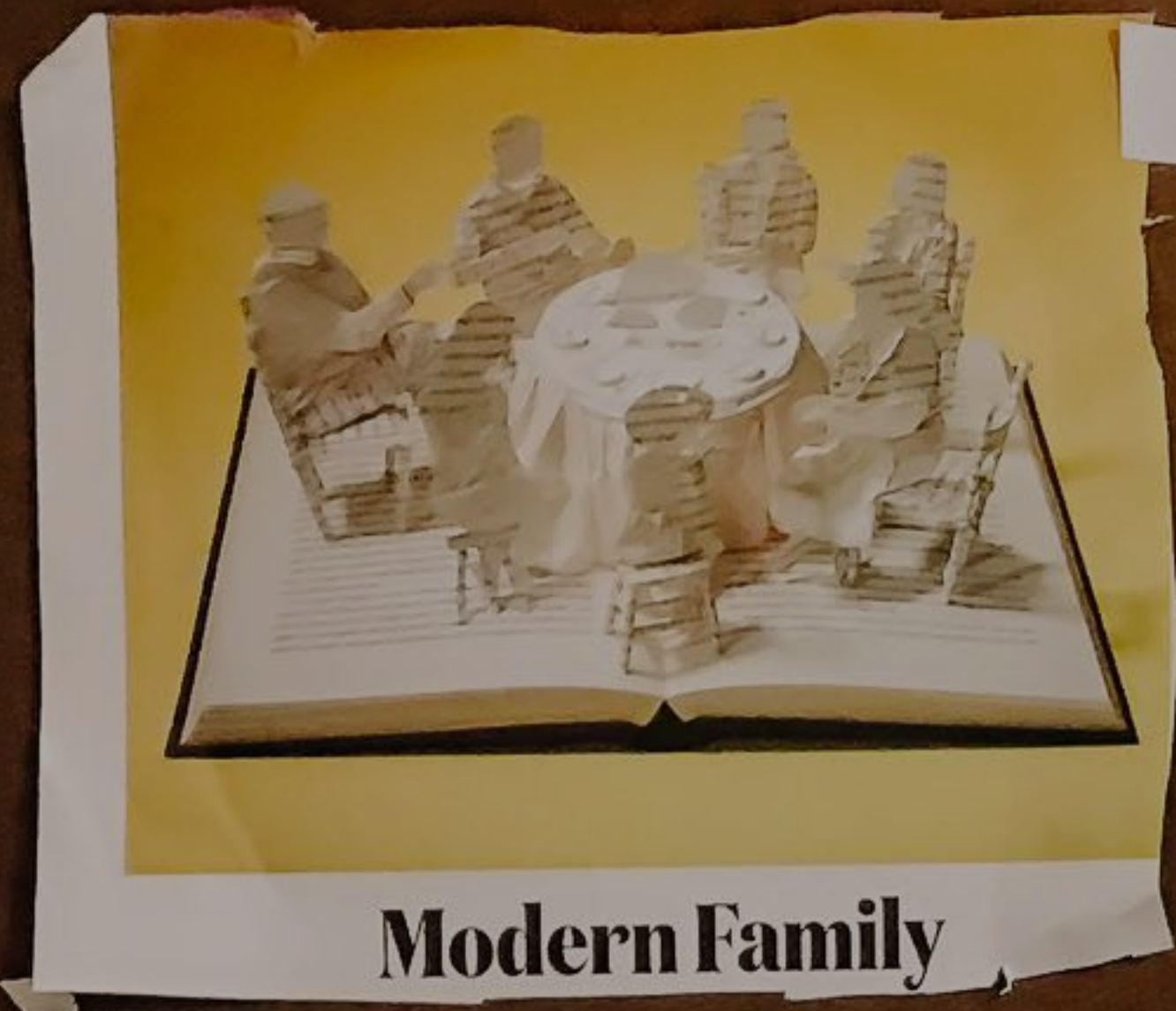


What does making room in your heart for Jesus mean?

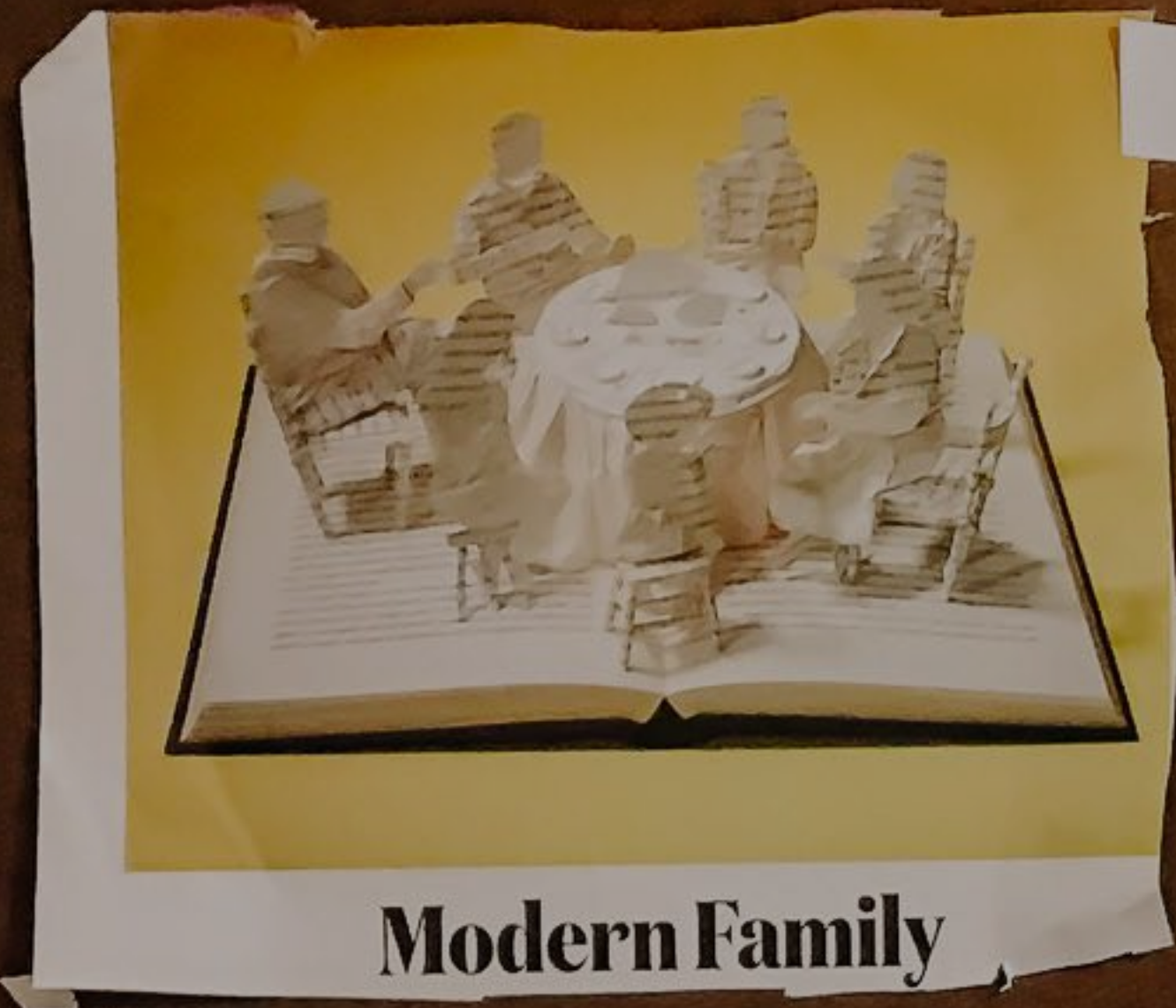

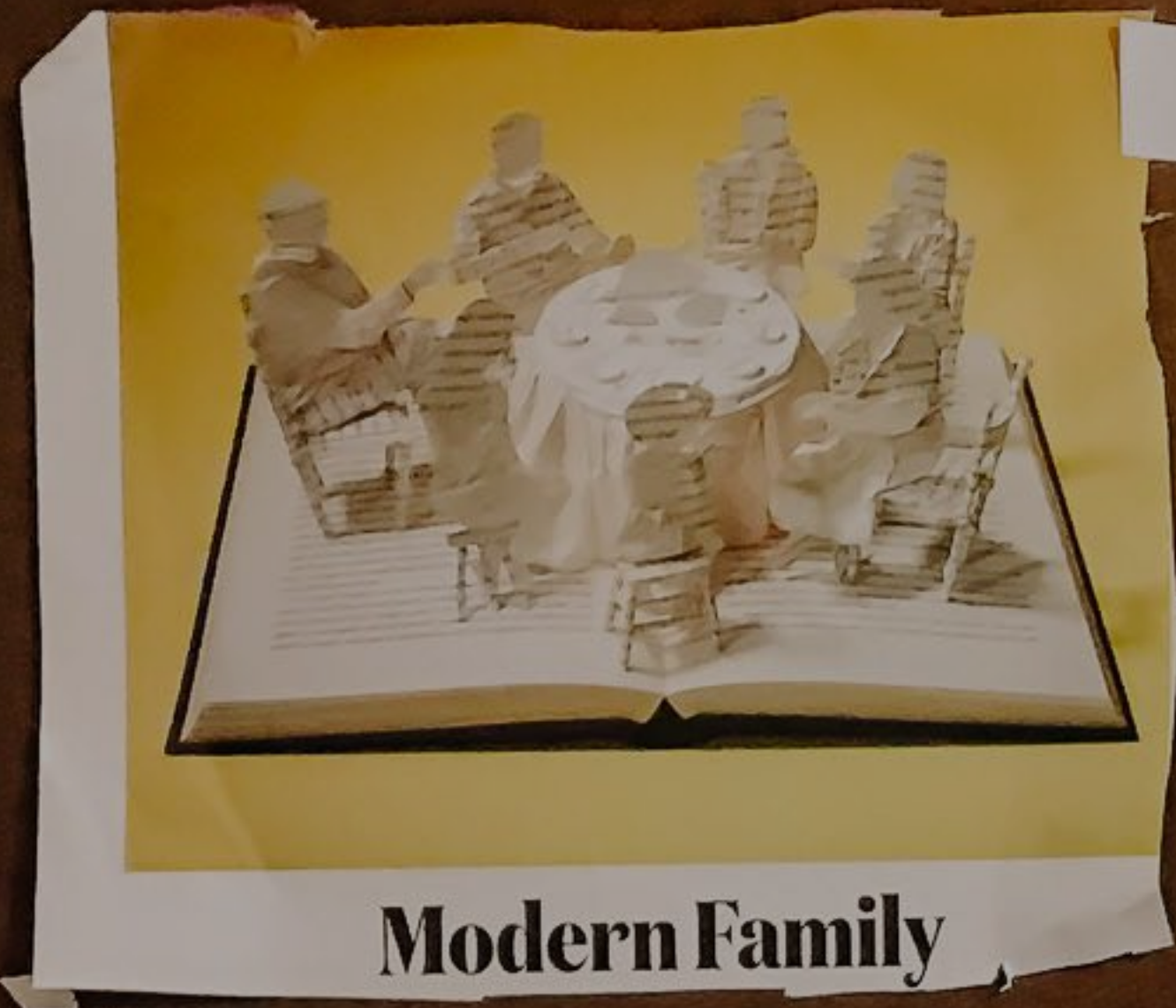


How do you practically make room for Jesus?
