Therefore, it offers us a prophetic description of our futures

#### Core beliefs:

God knows me, loves me and has the best for me
His ways are higher than my ways and His thoughts than my thoughts
His ways for me are specific and knowable
When I follow, things will go well for me

#### Proverbs 3:5-6 The Passion Translation

- <sup>5</sup> Trust in the Lord completely, and do not rely on your own opinions. With all your heart rely on him to guide you, and he will lead you in every decision you make.
- <sup>6</sup> Become intimate with him in whatever you do, and he will lead you wherever you go. Don't think for a moment that you know it all,
- <sup>7</sup> for wisdom comes when you adore him with undivided devotion and avoid everything that's wrong.

- 8 Then you will find the healing refreshment your body and spirit long for.
- <sup>9</sup> Glorify God with all your wealth, honoring him with your very best, with every increase that comes to you.
- Then every dimension of your life will overflow with blessings from an uncontainable source of inner joy!

# Growing our Trust John 1:12-13

While this verse talks about our **justification** (standing before God), it is also about our **sanctification** (our growth with God)

It is also prophetically descriptive of our future
