WHAT KIND OF FAITH HONORS GOD?

1. FAITH THAT BELIEVES WHEN IT DOESN'T SEE.

Faith is the confidence that what we hope for will actually happen; it gives us assurance about things we cannot see. Hebrews 11:1 NLT

2. FAITH THAT PERSISTS WHEN NOTHING CHANGES.

Be persistent in prayer, and keep alert as you pray, giving thanks to God. Colossians 4:2 GNT



3. FAITH THAT WORKS WHEN IT DOESN'T MAKE SENSE.

You see that [Abraham's] faith and his actions were working together, and his faith was made complete by what he did. James 2:22
