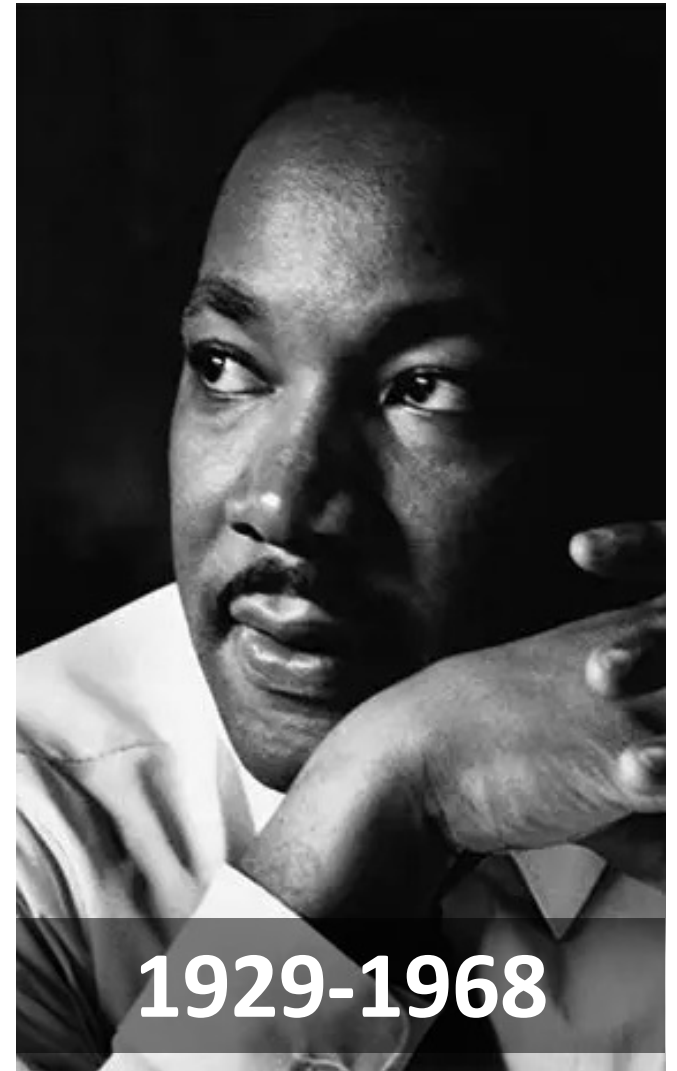
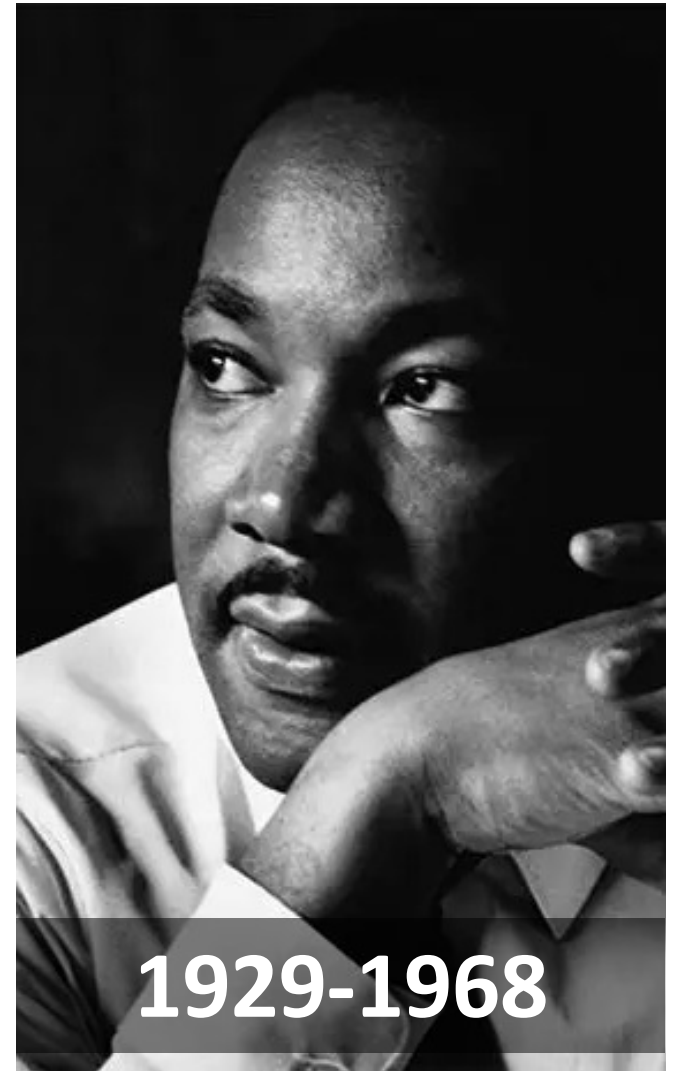

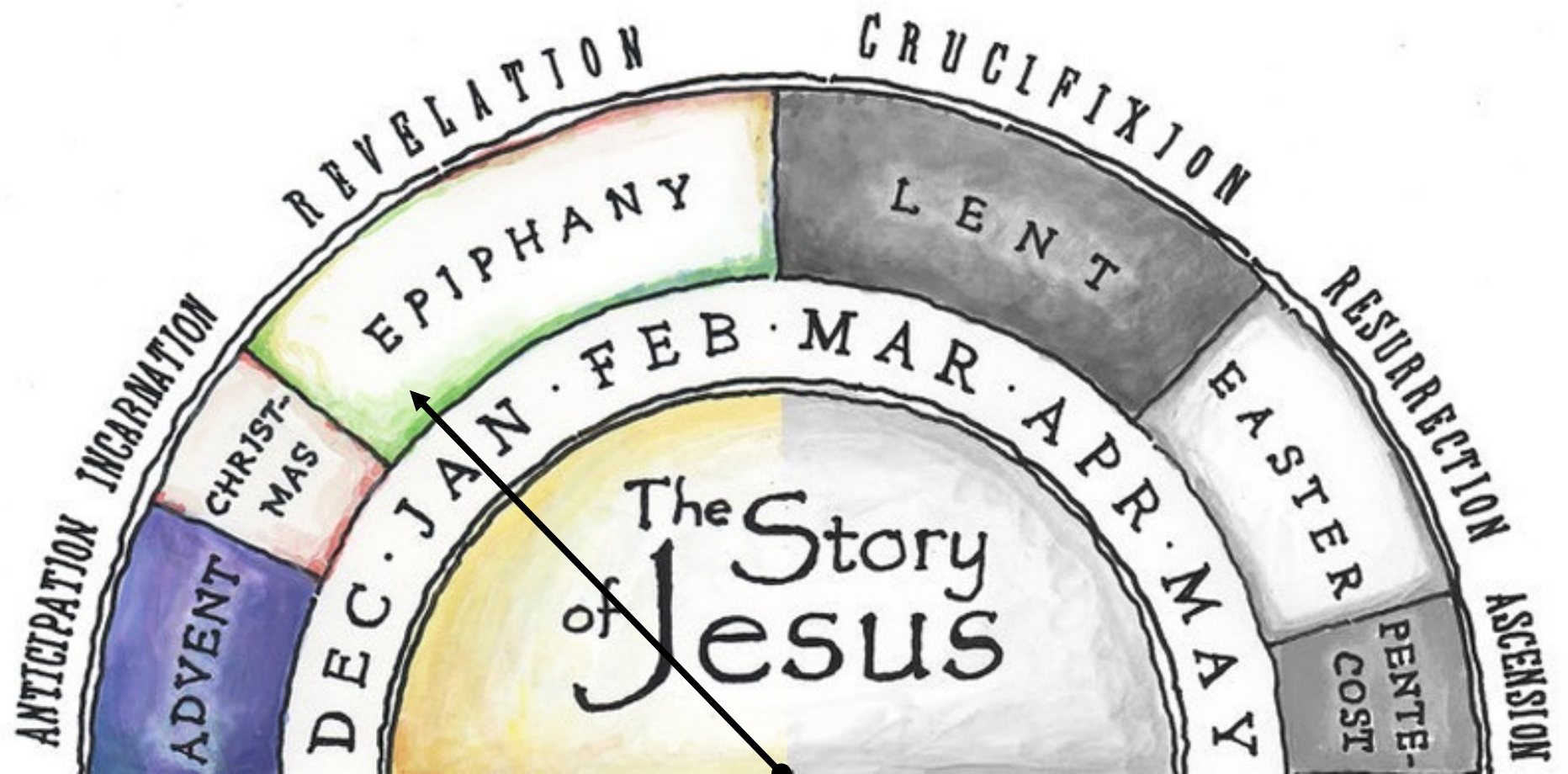


When laws dictate and pain is overlooked...

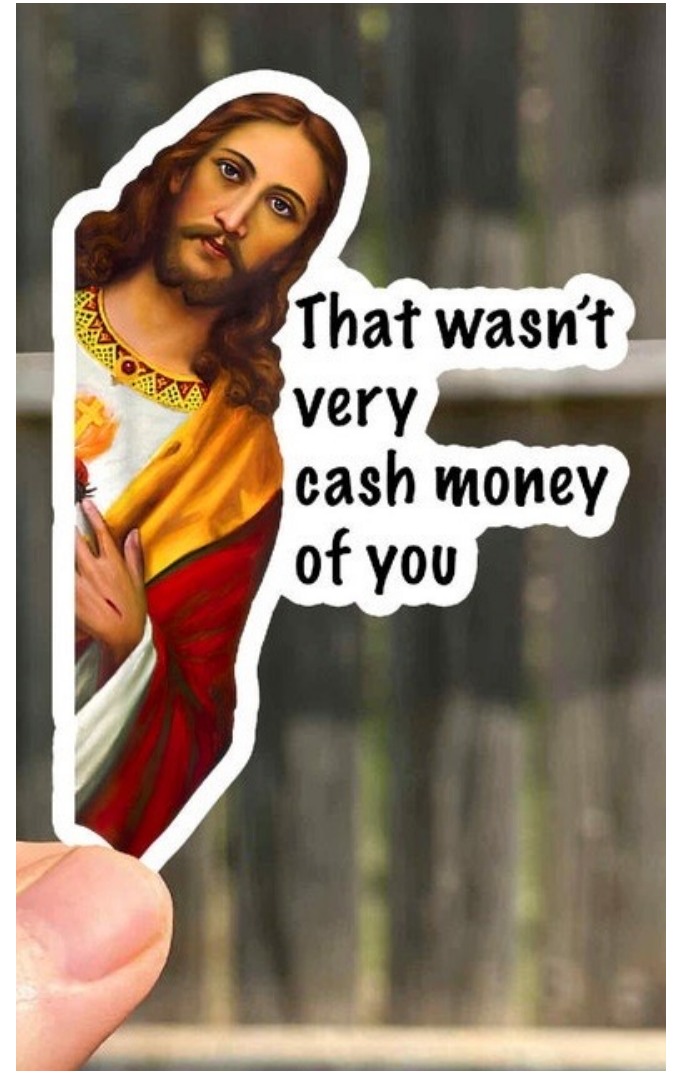

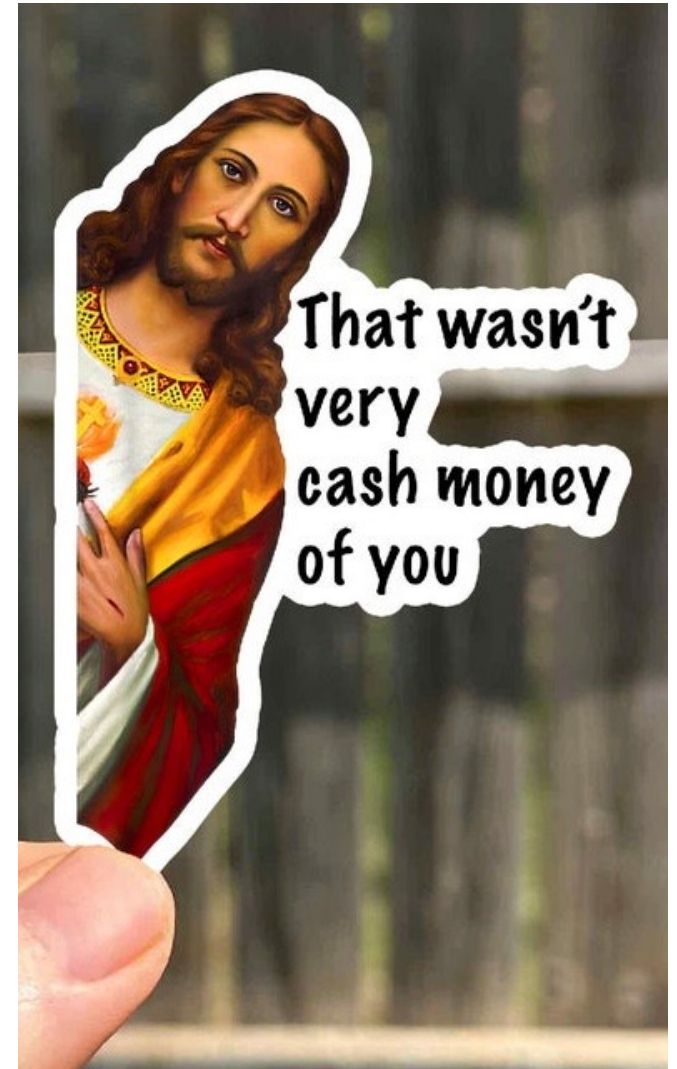

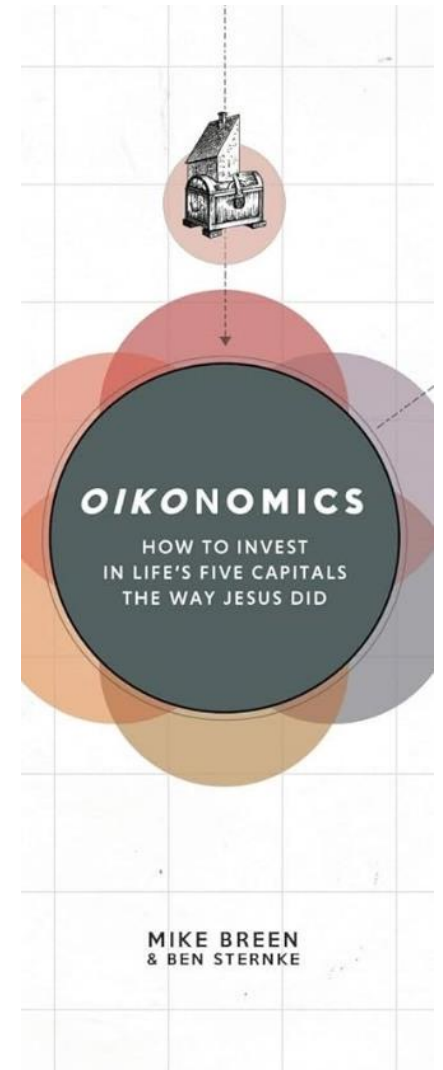

THE FIVE CAPITALS

Growing into the character + competency of Jesus requires discovering the joy of living generously with our:

- Spiritual equity *Wisdom, Love, etc.*
- Relational equity *Friends, connections, etc.*
- Physical resources *Available time/energy*
- Intellectual resources *Concepts/ideas*
- Financial resources *Dollars/Cents*

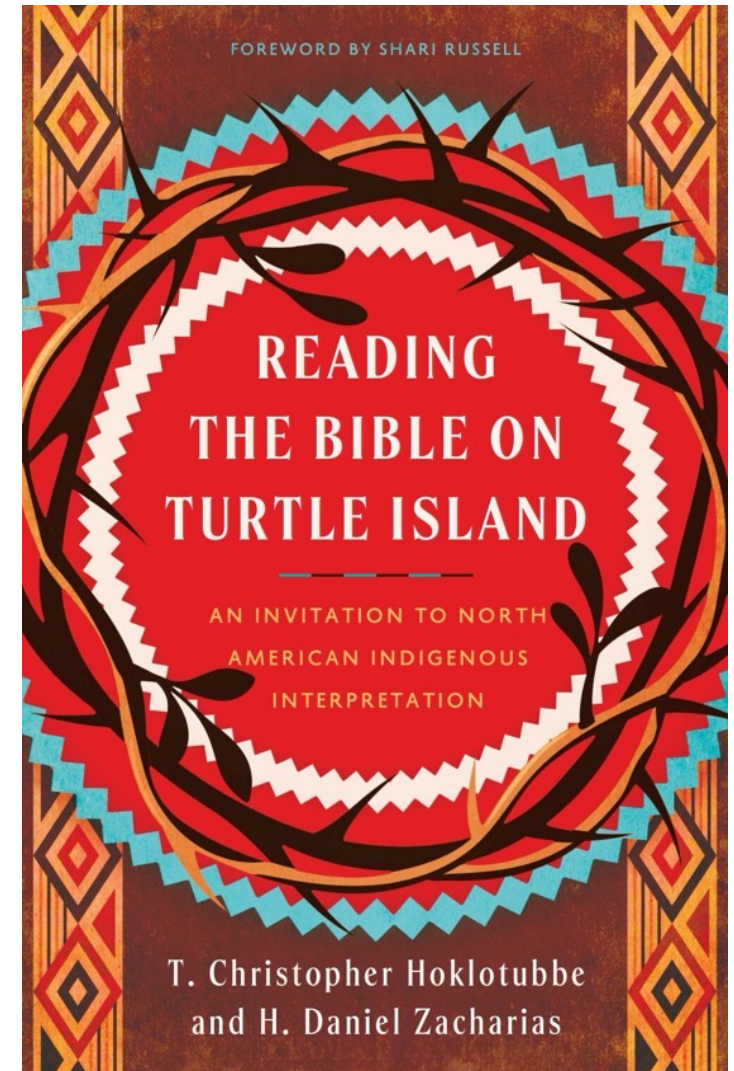

Turtle Island hermeneutics holds to...an *asset-based* theology (rooted in Gen 1, not Gen 3) that focuses on the strengths and potential of the community. It avoids focusing on problems and deficits, but chooses to identify assets already available that can be leveraged for positive change.

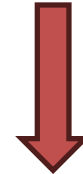

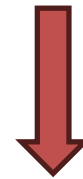

Jesus' teaching on money reveals Mammon as a false god which cannot be trusted, and cannot provide what it promises.

For Jesus, generosity is the force that helps us escape the gravitational force of Mammon/money/greed.

Jesus reveals the architecture of our hearts, how our inner life actually functions. If we get this “right,” if we grow a “healthy eye,” it will positively impact every other area in our lives.

Jesus gives us a practice to be engaged with over time. This isn't a switch that flips "on" and we're fully transformed in an instant. It is a practice that transforms us, slowly-but-surely, over time, into generous people.
