Recap – Part Five

- **Deuteronomy 12:5** *Rather you are to seek only the place Adonai your God chooses from all your tribes to put His Name to dwell—there you will come.* Deut 12:11-14, 14:23, 17:8-10
- God chose Jerusalem, specifically Mount Moriah: **1Kings 11:36, 1Chron 22:1, 2Chron 3:1**
- David Purchased Mount Moriah legally from the Jebusites.
- Why? That's where God found a partner in humanity that would give up His only son (Abraham) (**Gen 22:1-2, 10-12**) and receive him back (resurrected) (**Heb 11:17-19**). Therefore, that's where God chose to sacrifice His only son (**John 19:17**) who resurrected. That's why Yeshua is returning there, with all who resurrect to that place, the Land of Moriah: (**Act's 1:11 & Zech 14:4**).
- God will “again” choose Jerusalem, because that Covenant is Everlasting: **Zech 1:17 & 2:16**
- We pray for the Peace of Jerusalem **Psalms 122:6-9** Because peace will come from Zion.
- We are never to Forget Jerusalem **Psalms 137:5-6**, it is the apple of God's eye **Zech 2:12**
- Satan oppose this, and want to be worshiped in this place: **2Thesalonians 2:3-4**
- God has an outstanding promise to make Jerusalem a praise in the earth! **Isaiah 62:1-7**

Recap – Part Six

- Davids legal purchase of Mount Moriah **1Chron 21:18-28**, Solomon built the temple here **2Chronicles 3:1**. That's why Yeshua's lineage starts with Son of David, Son of Abraham (**Matt 1:1**). He is the legal inheritor of Mount Moriah from both.
- God lists the Everlasting Covenants as reason to return both Israel and Judah from exile and to restore Jerusalem – **Jeremiah 33**
- There is a set time for Jerusalem, both for restoration and for Destruction Tish B'Av. Yet God says that the fasts surrounding remembering Jerusalem's destruction shall become festivals of rejoicing! **Zechariah 8:18-23**
- The Abomination of Desolation was prophesied in Daniel, timing came forth perfectly in Chanukkah (**Daniel 8**) and again future facing to AD 70 (**Daniel 9**). Paul points to a future Abomination that culminates in Yeshua slaying the Anti-Messiah in **2 Thes 2**.
- In 96 AD (Post 70 AD Temple Destruction) **Revelation 11** gives a 3 ½ year timing to this trampling of the Temple again which matches **Daniel 12** timing on Messiah's return.
- The three unclean spirit from the mouth of the dragon are sent out to deceive the nations against Israel (**Rev 16:13-14**) are: Anti-Covenant, Anti-Covenant People, Anti-Covenant Land.

Part One: Brit Olam, A Covenant Forever!

Psalm 105:6-7 O seed of Abraham, His servant, O children of Jacob, His chosen ones. He is Adonai our God. His judgments are in all the earth.

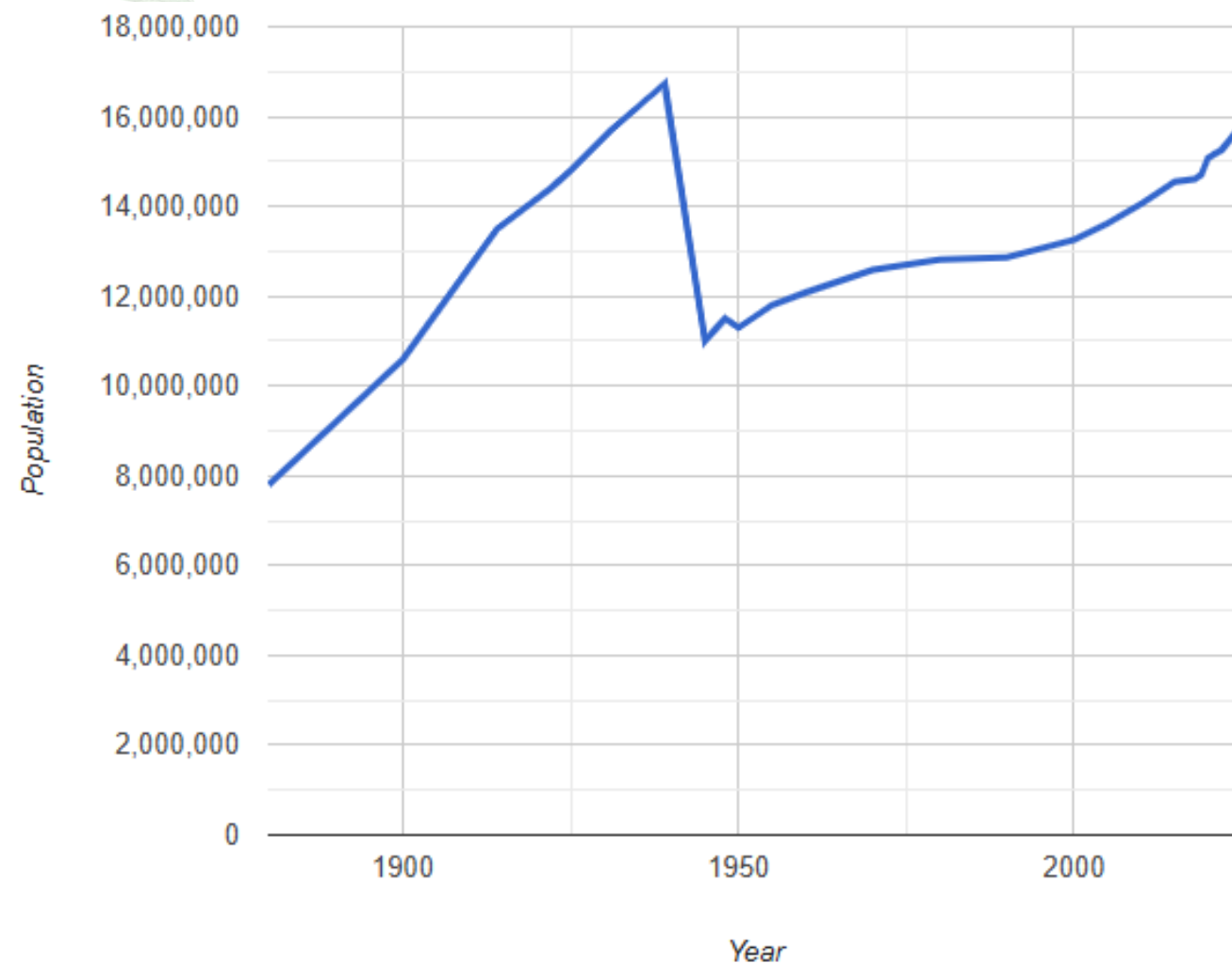
- **Whatever God is about to announce, impacts all people of the earth!**
- **Every human, in every land is accountable to God on this matter!**

Psalm 105:8-11 He remembers His covenant forever—the word He commanded for a thousand generations— which He made with Abraham, and swore to Isaac, and confirmed to Jacob as a decree, to Israel as an everlasting covenant, saying, “To you I give the land of Canaan, the portion of your inheritance.” (Gen 17:8)

- **Some consider this to be of no value. Replaced in Christ, or already fulfilled, some say the land covenant “is done away with”.**
- **Others have strong opinions against God on this.**
- **If a generation is 20 years = 20,000 years. If a generation is 40 years = 40,000**

Pursuing the 'seed' – Gen 3 & Rev 12

- If God's Covenant, People and Land were of no value, why did Satan pursue the physical seed in Nazi Germany, killing over 6 million Jews in the Holocaust?
- The Jewish population still has not recovered in total numbers yet.



Curses on those who oppose:

Genesis 12:2-3 My heart's desire is to make you into a great nation, to bless you, to make your name great so that you may be a blessing. My desire is to bless those who bless you, but whoever curses you I will curse, and in you all the families of the earth will be blessed."

- Isaac's blessing proclaimed to Jacob:

Genesis 27:29 May peoples serve you and may nations bow down to you. Be master over your brothers. May your mother's sons bow down to you. May those who curse you be cursed and may those who bless you be blessed."

- Speaking of Israel, Balaam proclaimed:

Numbers 24:9 He crouches like a lion or a lioness—who would rouse him? He who blesses you will be blessed, and he who curses you will be cursed."

- Those who Love Jerusalem will be at Peace!

Psalms 122:6 Pray for the peace of Jerusalem—"May those who love you be at peace!"

Curses on those who oppose:

- Those who encroach on God's borders will pay:

Zephaniah 2:8-9 I have heard the taunts of Moab and the jeers of the children of Ammon, who taunted My people and expanded on their border. Therefore, as I live, declares Adonai-Tzva'ot God of Israel, Moab will be like Sodom and Ammon like Gomorrah—a possession of weeds and a salt pit, a perpetual wasteland. The remainder of My people will plunder them. The remnant of My nation will dispossess them.

- Those opposing Jerusalem (confusion) are under a generational curse:

Psalms 137:7 Remember, Adonai, the children of Edom, what they said on the day Jerusalem fell: “Strip her, strip her to her very foundation!” O daughter of Babylon, the devastated one, happy is the one who repays you as you have paid us. Happy is the one who seizes your little ones and dashes them upon the rock.

Obadiah 1:10-15 “Because of your violence to your brother Jacob, shame will cover you, and you will be cut off forever. On the day that you stood aloof—on the day that strangers carried away his wealth, while foreigners entered his gates and cast lots for Jerusalem—you were just like one of them. You should not look down on your brother on the day of his disaster, nor should you rejoice over the children of Judah in the day of their destruction. You should not speak proudly in the day of their distress. Do not enter the gate of My people in the day of their disaster. Yes, you. Do not gloat over their misery in the day of their disaster. Yes, you—do not loot their wealth in the day of their calamity. Do not stand at the crossroad to cut down his fugitives, and do not imprison his survivors in the day of distress. “For the day of Adonai is near against all the nations. As you have done, it shall be done to you. Your dealing will return on your own head.

Curses on those who oppose:

- Egypt: **Exodus 7–12**. Opposed God's covenant people. Result: Ten Plagues.
- Amalek: **Exodus 17, Deuteronomy 25**. Attacked Israel from behind. Result: God declares perpetual war.
- Assyria: **Isaiah 10**. Used by God. Then became proud. Result: Judged.
- Babylon: **Jeremiah 50-51, Isaiah 47**. Destroyed Jerusalem. Result: Destroyed.
- Edom: **Psalms 137, Obadiah, Ezekiel 35**. Celebrated Jerusalem's destruction. Result: Permanent judgment.
- Tyre: **Ezekiel 26-28**. Rejoiced over Jerusalem. Result: Destroyed.

Not instant, but evil will not prosper:

Psalm 73:1-4 A psalm of Asaph. Surely God is good to Israel, to the pure in heart. But as for me, my feet almost slipped. My steps nearly slid out from under me. For I envied the arrogant, when I saw the prosperity of the wicked. For there are no pains at their death, their body is healthy.

Psalm 92:8-10 Though the wicked spring up like grass, and all evildoers flourish, it is only to be ruined forever. But You, Adonai, are exalted forever. For behold, Your enemies, Adonai—behold Your enemies perish—all evildoers are scattered.

Isaiah 54:15-17 Behold, anyone fiercely attacking is not from Me. Whoever stirs up strife with you will fall because of you. Behold, I created the smith who blows the fire of coals and produces a weapon for its work, and I created the destroyer to ruin. No weapon formed against you will prosper and you will condemn every tongue that rises against you in judgment. This is the heritage of Adonai's servants—their vindication is from Me.” It is a declaration of Adonai.

Enemies Unknowingly Serve God's Plan

Jeremiah 16:14-16 “Therefore, the days are quickly coming,” declares Adonai, “when it will no longer be said. ‘As Adonai lives, who brought up the children of Israel out of the land of Egypt.’ Rather, ‘As Adonai lives, who brought up the children of Israel from the land of the north and from all the lands where He had banished them.’ So I will bring them back into their land that I gave to their fathers. “Behold, I will send for many fishers,” says Adonai, “and they will fish for them. After that, I will send for many hunters, and they will hunt them down from every mountain and from every hill, and out of the clefts of the rocks.

- Some of the greatest persecution drove Jews to the Holy Land after WW2.
- Persecution will increase and continue to drive us back into the land. Yeshua said 12 times that we will be persecuted. Sell your coat for a sword!
- **Joel 2:1-11** A terrifying army that brings Gods people to repentance in **Joel 2:12-27** is also described in **Revelation 9:7-9**

A Nation Born in a Day?

Isaiah 66:7-14 Before she was in labor, she gave birth. Before her pain came, she delivered a male child. Who has heard such a thing? Who has seen such things? Can a land be born in one day? Can a nation be brought forth at once? For as soon as Zion was in labor, she gave birth to her children. “Will I bring the moment of birth, and not give delivery?” says Adonai. “Will I who cause delivery shut up the womb?” says your God. Rejoice with Jerusalem, and be glad with her, all you who love her. Rejoice for joy with her all you who mourned over her. For you will nurse and be satisfied from her comforting breast. You will drink deeply and delight from her glorious abundance. For thus says Adonai: “Behold, I will extend peace to her like a river, and the glory of the nations like an overflowing stream. You will be nursed, carried on the hip, and bounced on her knees. As one whom his mother comforts, so I will comfort you, so you will be comforted in Jerusalem. You will see, your heart will rejoice, and your bones will flourish like grass. So the hand of Adonai will be known to His servants, and His indignation to His enemies.

The attacks on the State of Israel

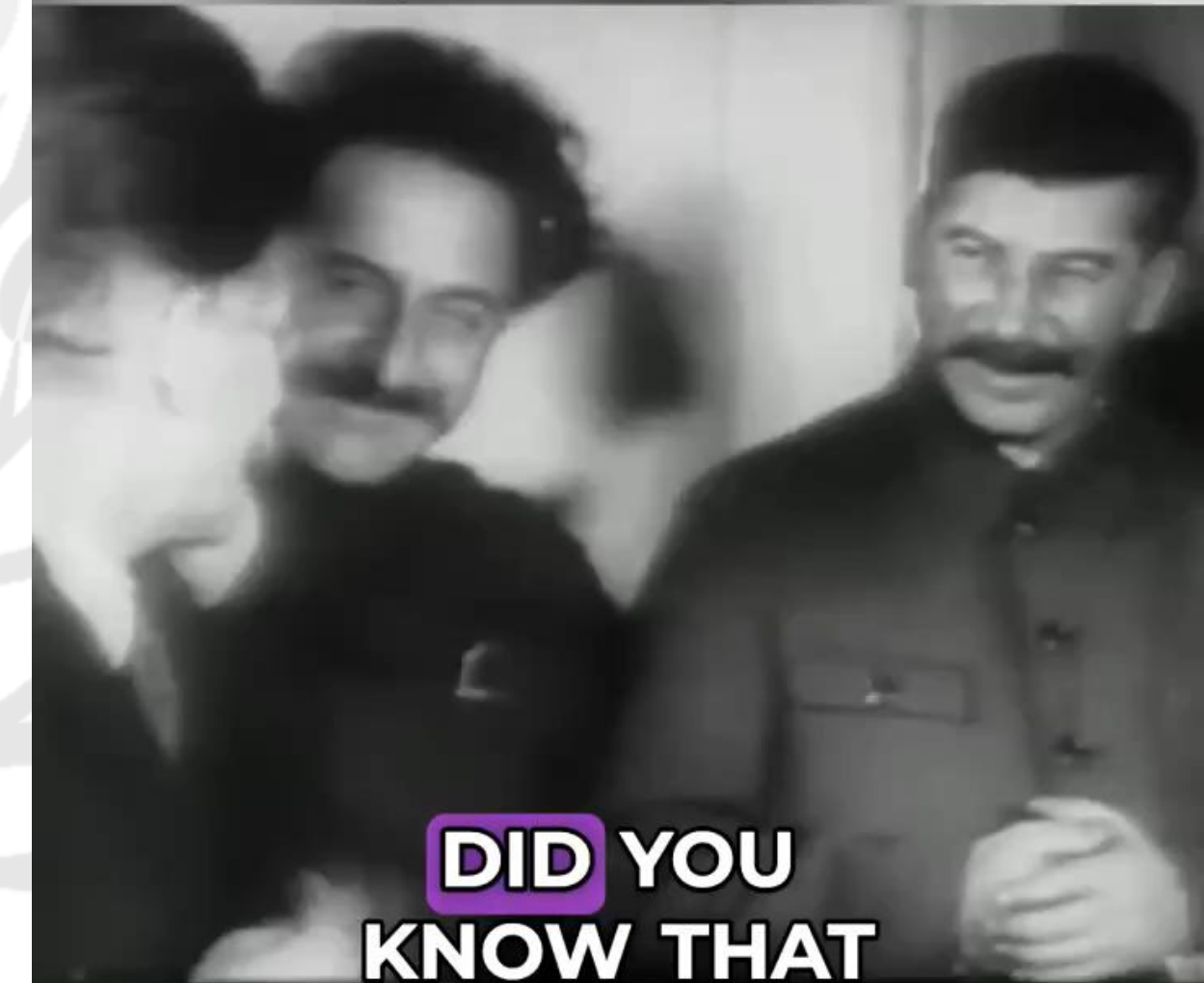
Year(s)	War	Main Opponents	Result
1947–1949	War of Independence	Arab militias, then Egypt, Jordan, Syria, Lebanon, Iraq	Israel survives and expands beyond the UN Partition borders.
1956	Suez Crisis (Sinai Campaign)	Egypt	Israel captures Sinai temporarily; later withdraws under international pressure.
1967	Six-Day War	Egypt, Jordan, Syria (with support from other Arab states)	Israel captures East Jerusalem, West Bank, Gaza, Sinai, and Golan Heights.
1969–1970	War of Attrition	Egypt	Prolonged artillery and air conflict along the Suez Canal; ended with a ceasefire.
1973	Yom Kippur War	Egypt and Syria (with support from Iraq, Jordan, others)	Initial surprise attack; Israel ultimately repels both fronts and regains the initiative.
1982–1985	First Lebanon War	PLO, Syria, Lebanese forces	PLO expelled from Beirut; prolonged Israeli presence in southern Lebanon followed.
2006	Second Lebanon War	Hezbollah	Inconclusive militarily, but Hezbollah suffered significant losses and UN Resolution 1701 followed.

The attacks on the State of Israel

- Almost instantaneously, Israel was attacked by Jordan, Egypt, Lebanon, Iraq & Syria with help from other Arab nations.
- Outnumbered and outgunned, especially in the first few decades, Israel fought valiantly and won the wars. Many in miraculous ways!
- Often the opposition to Israel led to gains by Israel!
- 1979 — Islamic Revolution; IRGC established. They Funded:
- 1982 — Hezbollah created in Lebanon.
- 1987–1992 — Hamas founded; ties with Iran deepen.
- 1990s–2000s — Palestinian Islamic Jihad, Iraqi militias supported.
- 2010s — Houthis and expanded regional proxy network.
- Today — "Axis of Resistance."

Israeli Favor Has Decline Amongst the Nations in the West

- The nation of Israel which once had the sympathy and support of the western world, has slowly lost favor due to its determined approach to fighting terrorism and refusal to give up territory.
- An antisemitic propaganda narrative has been proclaimed for over 50 years now in the mainstream media, focused on the youth.
 - Israel stole our land
 - Israelis are colonizers
 - Israel is Apartheid
 - Israelis are Nazis etc...
- These lies have found fertile ground in the hearts and mind of the historically illiterate everywhere, even amongst believers.



Those who Oppose God's Everlasting Covenant

- God doesn't care if it's Jews that oppose His Everlasting Covenant or Gentiles. All those who oppose it will suffer:
- Yitzchak Rabin (Israeli PM) conceded land and government recognition to the PLO in the Oslo accords of 1993. He was assassinated shortly after in 1995. *"Land for Peace"*
- Some scathing facts about Clinton became public knowledge shortly after.



Those who Oppose God's Everlasting Covenant

- Ariel Sharon (Israeli PM) announced plans (under pressure from President George Bush) to unilaterally withdrew from Gaza and parts of the “west bank” in 2003, and in 2005 he followed through with it.
- In total 9,000 Israelis in 21 communities were displaced of properties and businesses with little to no restitution for their losses.
- Shortly after (the same week): 1.5m displaced by Hurricane Katrina (That's 166 to 1).
- Shortly after, Sharon goes into a coma and dies of a stroke in 2006.
- Bush loses popularity and never recovers
- Paved the way for the left to come into Power (Obama).



Those who Oppose God's Everlasting Covenant

- Sharon was a mighty General that won many battles in war for Israel and should have known better!
- Not only that, but scripture has also foretold us this about Gaza (Stronghold):

Zephaniah 2:3-5 Seek Adonai, all you humble of the land who have executed His judgment. Seek righteousness; seek meekness! Perhaps you will be hidden on the day of Adonai's wrath. For Gaza will be abandoned and Ashkelon will be a wasteland. Ashdod will be driven out at noon and Ekron will be uprooted. Oy to the inhabitants of the seacoast, the nation of Cherethites! The word of Adonai is against you, Canaan, the land of the Philistines, and I will destroy you until there is no inhabitant.
- Read: **Ezekiel 25:15-17, Amos 1:6-8 & Zechariah 9:5-7**
- It was unwise to give the Land of the Everlasting Covenant to the enemy. Costly
- Gaza does not have an outstanding future because of the crimes it perpetrated on the Children of Israel. They broke the Everlasting Covenant! Look at History!

Those who Oppose God's Everlasting Covenant

- The Everlasting Covenant is God's word, if you go against it, you'll bring a curse and possibly death upon your own head. It's a Living Word!
- Many believers have opposed God on this, that doesn't mean they aren't saved per se, but it does mean that they will never be blessed.
- Even after giving Gaza to the enemy, peace was never to be had! It became a launching pad for Hamas terror. 18 years later, October 7th 2023 is on Sharon's head.
- Egypt was defeated many times in battle by Israel and have pursued peace treaties. However, Egypt allowed the munitions and equipment to get into Gaza through their border:

Joel 3:19-20 (4:19-20) But Egypt will be desolate and Edom a desert waste, because of the violence done to the people of Y'hudah, because they shed innocent blood in their land. Y'hudah will be inhabited forever, Yerushalayim through all generations.

- Edom is those who hate Israel.
- The 2023 raids were in the Ancient tribal territory of Judah.

7 Nations Occupy, Two Main Enemies

- Out of all of Israel's enemies, two stand out as the worst in Israel's modern History:
 - Syria and Iran.
 - Egypt was originally its biggest foe, after 5 modern era defeats, they signed a Peace treaty with Israel in 1979. (Scripture says it wont last **Zech 14**).
 - Jordan signed a Peace deal in 1994. (Bozrah **Isaiah 63**).
 - Iraq has never recovered from the Gulf Wars to be of relevance today.
 - Saudi Arabia assisted in some of the early wars financially, but have refrained and are neutral today. Assisting the US against Iran today.
 - Lebanon has a weak government and is used by Hezbollah (**Isaiah ?**).
 - The final Caliphate may come from Turkey.

Syria and Damascus

- **Syria never came to a Peace agreement with Israel.**
- **Ruled by Hafez Al Asad beginning in 1971, as an iron fist police state, brutal dictatorship, funded by Russia to counter the US in Israel.**
- **Ends up seceding territory to Israel because of it's opposition to the Everlasting Covenant (Golan Heights, East of Galilee, High ground, 1967).**
- **The Everlasting Covenant curse caught up to the Al Asad family in 2011 when Syria became engulfed in civil war. Bashar Al Asad fled the country.**
- **13 Million Syrians have been displaced, almost 1 million killed.**
- **For its unending hate for Israel, Syria has suffered.**
- **Today, Syria is a stronghold for Iranian terror funding through Hezbollah.**
- **Syria will never be a peace partner:**

Isaiah 17:1 This is a prophecy about Dammeseck: "Dammeseck will soon stop being a city; it will become a heap of ruins.

Iran and Hezbollah

- Hezbollah means “Party of Allah” has direct ties to the Ayatollah's in Iran.
- Supplying munitions, rockets and terror through Syria.
- Suffering for opposing the Everlasting Covenant:
- Great “pager” event of 2024 killed 1,500 of its leaders.
- Iran has dedicated its purpose to the Destruction of Israel.
- Because of this its leaders and people have suffered greatly, so much has been lost in Iran because of the curse of the Everlasting Covenant.
- Iran will not be a future peace partner:
- Persia is the first to join Gog & Magog **Ezekiel 35:5**

Jeremiah 49:34-39 This is the word of Adonai that came to Yirmeyahu the prophet concerning `Eilam at the beginning of the reign of Tzidkiyahu king of Y'hudah:
"Adonai-Tzva'ot says: 'I will break `Eilam's bow, the mainstay of their might. I will bring against `Eilam the four winds from the four quarters of the sky and scatter them to all those winds. There will not be one nation to which the dispersed of `Eilam will not come. I will break `Eilam before their foes, before those who seek their lives; I will bring disaster on them, my burning anger,' says Adonai. 'I will send the sword to pursue them until I have finished them off. I will put my throne in `Eilam and destroy their king and leaders,' says Adonai. 'But in the acharit-hayamim, I will bring back the exiles of `Eilam,' says Adonai."

Lebanon's Weak Government

- Lebanon's weak Government makes it a proxy Ally to Israel's enemies through terror groups like Hezbollah.
- Lebanon will likely be completely owned by Israel in the Messianic Kingdom, alongside much of the Mideast, and the 7 nations that occupy God's land.
- They don't appear to be a future Peace partner:

Obadiah 1:19-21 Those in the Negev will repossess the mountain of `Esav, and those in the Sh'felah the land of the P'lishtim; they will repossess the field of Efrayim and the field of Shomron, and Binyamin will occupy Gil`ad. Those from this army of the people of Isra'el exiled among the Kena`anim as far away as Tzarfat, and the exiles from Yerushalayim in S'farad, will repossess the cities in the Negev. Then the victorious will ascend Mount Tziyon to rule over Mount `Esav, but the kingship will belong to Adonai.

- Tzarfat is a Lebanese village, just north of the Latini River:
- The IDF is currently occupying this area and removing towns to create a buffer zone between Israel and Lebanon!

Israel is pushing forward with plans to remove Lebanese homes and residents from between the Litani River and its own border, creating a buffer zone. Why is the area strategically important in the Middle East conflict?

A small river has become a flashpoint in a broader regional conflict: The course of the 145-kilometer (90-mile) Litani River in **Lebanon** mirrors the front lines of the conflict between Hezbollah and Israel.

The Litani River also highlights the current fragility of international law. Despite the growing escalation in Lebanon between **Israel** and **Hezbollah**, the mandate of the long-standing **UN** mission UNIFIL — which has stationed international peacekeeping forces in the border region since 1978 — is set to expire at the end of the year.

Wisdom

Acts 5:34-39 But a certain Pharisee named Gamaliel, a teacher of the Torah respected by all the people, stood up in the Sanhedrin and gave orders to put the men outside for a little while. Then he said to them, “Men of Israel, be careful what you are about to do with these men. For some time ago Theudas rose up, claiming to be somebody; and a number of men, maybe four hundred, joined up with him. He was killed, and all who followed him were scattered and came to nothing. After this fellow, Judah the Galilean rose up in the days of the census and got people to follow him. He also perished, and all who followed him were scattered. So now I tell you, stay away from these men and leave them alone. For if this plan or undertaking is of men, it will come to an end; but if it is of God, you will not be able to stop them. You might even be found fighting against God.” They took his advice,

- This is wisdom. If the State of Israel is not by the hand of God, then it will fizzle out and come to nothing. Israel will perish.
- If it is of God and you oppose it, you will be fighting God himself on this matter.
- Do your homework, know the times. Israel is here to stay as Messiahs return is near

Share God's Heart On The Matter:

- Here is what God says:

Zechariah 1:14-17 Then the angel speaking to me said, ‘Cry out saying, thus says Adonai-Tzva’ot, “I am exceedingly zealous for Jerusalem and for Zion and I am infuriated with the haughty nations. I was a little angry with them, but they furthered their own calamity.” “Therefore,” thus says Adonai, “I will return to Jerusalem with compassion. My House will be built there,” declares Adonai-Tzva’ot “and a measuring line will be stretched out over Jerusalem.” Again cry out, saying, thus says Adonai-Tzva’ot, “My cities will again overflow with prosperity and Adonai will again comfort Zion and will again choose Jerusalem.”

Joel 3:16 (4:16) Adonai will roar from Tziyon, he will thunder from Yerushalayim, the sky and the earth will shake. But Adonai will be a refuge for his people, a stronghold for the people of Isra'el.

- Don't fall for the deception belched from the mouth of the Dragon, the beast & false prophet. **Rev 16**
