HEAVENLY BEINGS IN THE OT

01. TERMS THAT DESCRIBE THEIR NATURE:

ELOHIM - GODS - THOSE THAT DWELL IN THE DIVINE REALM

¹God has taken his place in the divine council; in the midst of the gods he holds judgment:

SPIRIT/SPIRITS – NON-EMBODIED ENTITIES

HOLY ONES - THOSE THAT DWELL WITH GOD IN HIS HOLINESS

HEAVENLY ONES - THOSE THAT DWELL IN THE HEAVENS

⁵Let the [HEAVENLY BEINGS] praise your wonders, O LORD, your faithfulness in the assembly of the holy ones! ⁶For who in the skies can be compared to the LORD? Who among the heavenly beings is like the LORD, ⁷a God greatly to be feared in the council of the holy ones, and awesome above all who are around him? ⁸O LORD God of hosts, who is mighty as you are, O LORD, with your faithfulness all around you?

02. TERMS THAT DESCRIBE FUNCTION:

HOSTS/MIGHTY ONES - MEMBERS OF THE LORDS ARMY

MINISTER - THOSE THAT SERVE THE LORD AND MAN

03. TERMS THAT DESCRIBE STATUS IN HIERARCHY

A range of terms in the Old Testament describe this heavenly bureaucracy:

- "assembly" (lemma: 'ēdāh; construct form: 'adat)
- •"council" (sōd)
- •"congregation" (qāhāl)
- "assembly, assembled meeting" (mô 'ēd)
- •"court" (Aramaic: dîn)¹

HEAVENLY BEINGS IN THE NT

They are occasionally described as "spirits" (Heb 1:14; Rev 1:4; 3:1; 4:5; 5:6),11 "heavenly ones" (epouranioi; 1 Cor 15:48), "glorious ones" (doksai; 2 Pet 2:10; Jude 8); "lights" (phōtōn; Jas 1:17); "holy ones" (hagiais; Jude 14); and (possibly) "stars."²

¹² For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the cosmic powers over this present darkness, against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly places.

THESE TERMS ALL CONNOTE GEOGRAPHICAL DOMAIN AUTHORITY!

ENOCH RECORDS THE REBELLION OF THE SONS OF GOD IN GENESIS 6 TAKING PLACE AT MT. HERMON.

MOUNT HERMON at 9,000 feet is the tallest mountain in Israel. The base of Mount Hermon is the northern border region of Bashan. Bashan is first mentioned in the OT in Deuteronmy 2-3 as God directs Moses to lead the Israelites in preparation for conquest of the Promised Land. Readers of Deuteronomy 2-3 discover that the Transjordan was once the home of giant clans, referred to variously as Rephaim, Anakim, Emim, Zamzummin, and Amorites.3 This is the Caananite version of Hell or the Underworld.

In Jesus' day, Caesarea Philippi was also called Panias, having been dedicated to the worship of Pan. When viewed from this perspective, the scene takes place on geography considered the gates of hell in Old Testament times, the domain of Baal, the lord of the dead, and at the mountain where the plot of the Watchers was hatched. Hell, of course, wouldn't be complete without the devil. It is well known to scholars that Baal is the Old Testament counterpart to the devil. In Ugaritic, one of Baal's titles is ba'al zebul 'ars ("Prince Baal of the Underworld"), from which the New Testament Beelzebul and Beelzebub derive.

²And after six days Jesus took with him Peter and James and John, and led them up a high mountain by themselves.
