## An Update From The Kidd Family

Dear Friends and Co-Laborers in Christ,

Thank you to all who were praying for the school project that we were preparing for!! The team from PREACH arrived safely in Praia on September 18th. Then on the 22nd, the team, my family, and a couple nationals traveled to the island of São Nicolau. I had already travelled there 2 times previously to make preparations, so things were pretty well set for us. The island only has around 3,000 students between 22 different morning and afternoon sessions, but because of the difficulty in traveling the island, we split into 2 groups. The schools had anywhere from 9 to 500+ students. God opened wide the doors for this project!! We only had resistance at one school and that was resolved the next day after a visit with the equivalent of the school superintendent. We started on Tuesday morning and finished the distribution Thursday afternoon. The evenings were spent in good godly fellowship and time of devotions. Sometimes we forget just how much we miss fellowshiping with fellow Americans who are also like-minded believers.

We had also planned an evangelistic campaign to assist Templo Baptista Independente em Mindelo, but due to a cancelled flight we were not able to make the trip to the island of São Vicente with the group. Inter-island travel has become very unreliable the last couple years. While it was very disappointing for us all and Pastor Edson and his family, our Lord knows all and had a reason for allowing this to happen.

Some have asked about the situation with the 4 children who were staying with our family and the pastor's family here in Praia. We tried to get them into a healthy group home setting, but their father refused this option. So, as of now, they are all back at home with their father. Please continue to pray for Carlisa, Taissa, Davi, and Jonathan.

The 3 churches that we are involved with are faithfully continuing their evangelistic efforts. However, the last several months there has not been much fruit. We know that many seeds have been planted and that God gives the increase. Please pray that the pastors and members would not "be weary in well doing."

We also ask that you continue in prayer with us, PREACH Teams, as we are continuing with the vision of opening a Christian school in the English language here in Praia. The primary objective is evangelizing the students and their parents for Christ. If this be God's will, we need for Him to open some doors so that we can continue with our preparations. There is a lot of government bureaucracy and many expenses involved, but God is able.
