Dear Prayer Warriors,

God is always faithful! We are thankful to report that the recent trip to Argentina and Uruguay went smoothly. My departure was on May 18. My flight originated from Tampa, Florida to Houston, Texas and then on to Buenos Aires. The initial time in Buenos Aires was brief. Missionary Pastor D.A. Brosius picked me up at the airport and provided transportation for much of the time I was there. He and I visited several Jewish friends that first day. The following day I traveled to Tucumán, Argentina. Missionary Pastor Larry Owens met me at the airport, and I stayed with him and his dear wife, Alma, for the weekend. The next day, Brother Horacio Mora, IBJM representative and I visited various Jewish contacts, inviting them to the Honor Israel meetings which were scheduled at Iglesia Bautista Bet-Él the next day. The evening before, our Jewish friend, Marcos invited us to his daughter's home. While there, we took time to share the gospel with Marcos, his wife, Delicia, his daughter, Daniella, and her fiancé, Ezequiel. During that time, we warned them of the upcoming Tribulation and how Jesus the Messiah provides us with salvation and deliverance from the judgment that will occur during the Tribulation. We encouraged those who were able, to attend church services that next day. We were blessed by the attendance of Marcos and Delicia in the morning service. Although neither one made a decision to trust Christ as Savior, they expressed their contentment with having attended.

The following day began a three-day session of teaching in the Bible institute at the church. There were afternoon and evening sessions so that the students could have time to work and cover their expenses. The combined attendance was 39 students. I was asked to teach *How One can Share His Faith with a Jewish Person*. The class was well received. From Tucumán, I traveled back to Buenos Aires where Pastor Brosius had asked that we hold an Honor Israel meeting during the Sunday morning service. God blessed the service, and there were about 80 people in attendance. While in Buenos Aires, I visited different Jewish contacts. One couple I visited on more than one occasion is Pedro and Ana. Just before I left the country, Pedro was involved in a motorcycle accident. Thankfully, there was no loss of life. Pray that God would use the accident to cause Pedro and Ana to seek Him and come to a saving knowledge of Jesus as Messiah and Savior.

From Buenos Aires, I traveled to Uruguay to see the Andrés Ramirez family. Andrés invited me to preach his midweek and Sunday evening services. He is working on various outreaches near his church plant in Nueva Helvecia. We visited a new Jewish contact he had recently met. Please pray for the salvation of Mauricio. For the weekend, I met up with Victoria and Miriam Gaguine, Hebrew Christians who have labored with IBJM for over 50 years witnessing to Jewish and Gentile people and holding Everlasting Nation Fellowship meetings in their home for much of that time. Please pray for them as they are in their eighties. God has used them greatly for many years. The sisters arranged for me to preach in Tabernacle Bíble Baptist Church that Sunday morning in eastern Montevideo. This church is pastored by Missionary Larry Carlisle.
