



whom alone we worship and serve.**

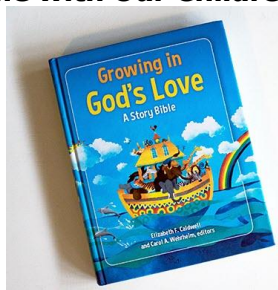
**We trust in God the Holy Spirit,
