

who has spoken through the prophets.**

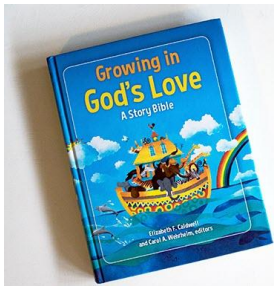
