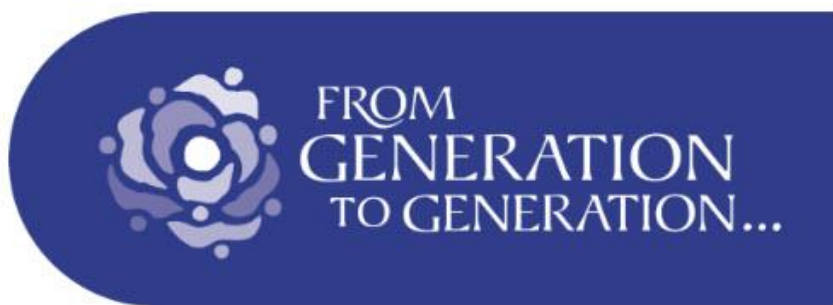
Alphabet of Gratitude
