
Open Choir Opportunity Sunday, September 3

September CPC Drive-Thru Flu Vaccine Clinic Canceled

During the COVID pandemic, our CPC clinic provided a chance to get the flu vaccine without leaving a car. Due to the closing of our last pharmacy clinic provider, CPC will not be a primary vaccination site this year. We regret any inconvenience this may cause.

The CPC Deacons Transportation Team can provide a member who can't drive due to a medical condition with a lift to their physician's office for flu vaccination. The flu season will soon be upon us, so get your flu vaccine as soon as possible. The CDC recommends getting it in September or October. Flu vaccination is now available through most healthcare providers, plus many pharmacies, grocery stores, and other community vaccination sites.
