

Old Man and New Man – Transformed Session 3

Foundational Truths:

The crucifixion of the Old Man (Romans 6:6)

The giving of new life in Jesus (2 Corinthians 5:17)

Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away, behold, all things become new.

A. The Nature of the Old Man

1. The Old Man is the Self Inherited from Adam (Romans 5:12 and Romans 5:18)
2. The Old Man is called the *Natural Man* (1 Corinthians 2:14)
3. The Old Man is our sin nature (Romans 2:14-16)
4. The Old Man displays his influence through the flesh (mind, will, emotions)

B. What Happens at Conversion

1. The Old Man is dead, crucified with Christ (Romans 6:6, Romans 6:8-12)
2. The New Man is imparted, given (Ephesians 4:24, Colossians 3:10)
3. The New Man is the *real self* (Romans 7:15-17)

C. The Remaining Power of the Flesh

1. The Old Man is dead, and we are called to reckon him so (Galatians 5:16-17)
2. The Flesh lives on until resurrection, and we are to crucify the flesh (Galatians 5:24)
