**INVITATION TO THE LORD'S SUPPER** In this morning's service, we celebrate Holy Communion. We offer Communion at the altar as well as individual communion kits if you are not yet comfortable with coming up. Individual kits can be found at the entrances or you may ask one of our ushers for assistance. If you wish to commune at the altar, our ushers will come and invite you forward, row by row, when the time comes. As Lutheran Christians, we believe that this sacrament is more than just a memorial meal. We believe in Christ's real presence in, under, and through the bread and the wine for the forgiveness of sins. If you are a baptized Christian, and this is what you believe and desire, we invite you to join us in this most sacred meal! If this is not your confession, or you are not sure what you believe about the Lord's Supper, we are thankful that you are worshiping with us but ask that you please refrain from taking communion today. Our pastoral staff would be happy to follow up with you about participating in Holy Communion in the future.

**FOR OUR LITTLE ONES** For parents who have children under four years of age, we have a staffed nursery to assist you. If you have an infant, please feel free to use our Cry Room where you can still see and listen to the worship service.

## CONFESSION AND FORGIVENESS

P: Fellow brothers and sisters in Christ, on this holy day when we recall Christ's ascension into heaven, we are reminded that though the earthly life of Christ is completed, He is still active within His creation. However, as we will hear in our Gospel Reading, we are very much in the world that hates us on account of Christ. Sometimes, we despair and fall back into sinful, worldly habits. For those times, let us use the words of Psalm 121 to both confess and remember God's goodness to us. *(please kneel)*

P: I lift up my eyes to the hills. From where does my help come?

C: **My help comes from the LORD, who made heaven and earth.**

P: We stumble in darkness of sin; we are vulnerable against temptation.

C: **Yet God will not let your foot be moved; He who keeps you will not slumber. Behold, He who keeps Israel will neither slumber nor sleep**

P: We are afflicted in every way, but not crushed; perplexed, but not driven to despair; persecuted, but not forsaken; struck down, but not destroyed. (2 Cor 4:8-9).

C: **The LORD is your keeper; the LORD is your shade on your right hand. The sun shall not strike you by day, nor the moon by night.**

P: Therefore, since we have a great high priest who has ascended into heaven, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold firmly to the faith we profess. (Hebrews 4:14)

C: **The LORD will keep you from all evil; he will keep your life. The LORD will keep your going out and your coming in from this time forth and forevermore.** *(silence follows for personal confession)*

P: Almighty God in His mercy, is our Keeper, and has sent His Son to be our Savior. The Good News for us is that by Jesus' death and resurrection, sin, death, and the devil have been defeated. As Jesus has ascended to the right hand of the Father, our future hope is certain for just as "He was taken up from you into heaven, he will come in the same way as you saw him go into heaven." Therefore, as a called and ordained servant of the Word, and by His authority, I forgive you all of your sins in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.

## CONFESSION OF FAITH

L: Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ, since Christ has conquered sin and death, and ascended into heaven, let us confess what we believe about our Lord. What does Jesus dying, rising, and ascending mean for us?

C: **I believe that has redeemed me, a lost and condemned person, purchased and won me from all sins, from death, and from the power of the devil; not with gold or silver, but with His holy, precious blood and with His innocent suffering and death.**

L: Since Jesus is both fully God and man, we refer to His earthly ministry as the state of humility, when He often hid His divinity. However, He now lives in a state of exultation since death could not contain Him. What does this state of exultation mean for our understanding of who Jesus is and what He has done?

C: **It highlights the full and deep sense in which Jesus, as our Brother, has been exalted by God the Father over sin, death, and the devil so that our future in Him is secure.**

L: What comfort does the state of exaltation bring us?

C: **It means that Jesus has ascended to the right hand of God and now rules for our benefit. It also means that He will return in glory as judge on the Last Day and bring us into His new creation. He sanctifies us by His Holy Spirit, and defends us against the devil and power of sin.**
