Three Killers of Humility

1. Jealousy (1 Samuel 18:6-9)
2. Pride (1 Samuel 18:10-30)
3. Stubbornness (1 Samuel 19)

Saul's Jealousy (1 Samuel 18:6-9)

- Saul "eyed" David—"watched jealously"
- Jealousy is a product of not trusting God's sovereign will; that we know what's better for us than He does.



Saul's Pride (1 Samuel 18:10-30)

- "God is opposed to the proud but gives grace to the humble."
- Are you softened by God's grace?

Saul's Stubbornness (1 Samuel 19)

- Saul attempts to kill David 12 times in this story
- God's will was stronger than Saul's stubbornness

The Warning Signs

1. Jealousy
2. Pride
3. Stubbornness
4. Not trusting God's sovereign will
5. Manipulating situations

The Remedies

1. Trust God's will completely
2. Deny ourselves, and take up Jesus' cross
3. Embrace humility
