WARNING SIGNS THE LIFE OF KING SAUL IN 1 SAMUEL

Delight your heart in God, and you will live a life that delights Him.

Command Given (1 Samuel 15:1-3)

*Samuel's authority established; *Background: Who are the Amalekites? *The command to Saul.



Command Response and Violation (1 Samuel 15:4-9)

*Saul starts well; *Saul's intent to disobey God; *Partial obedience.

Warning Sign #1=Saul doesn't listen to God; Lesson=Pay attention to God, and obey Him fully.



Confrontations and Excuses (1 Samuel 15:10-21)

*God's regret;

Warning Sign #2=Saul disobeys God, and allows for separation between the Lord and himself; Lesson=Don't allow disobedience to God to separate you from Him.



Confrontations and Excuses (1 Samuel 15:10-21)

*A monument is built;

Warning Sign #3=Saul hoards honor and attention for himself; Lesson=Give all the glory to God.

*Saul's inaccurate proclamation; blame-shifting!; *Saul holds the voice of the people higher than God's.

Confrontations and Excuses (1 Samuel 15:10-21)

*Saul holds the voice of the people higher than God's.

Warning Sign #4=Saul places other voices and influences above God's; Lesson=Hold God's voice in highest place above all others.

*Contrast between Saul and David.



Samuel's Response (1 Samuel 15:22-23)

*Weighty finality: origin and critical nature; *God wants our heart; *The best sacrifice; *Saul rejected as king.

Warning Sign #5=Saul offers sacrifices, but he remains disobedient; Lesson=Surrender your whole heart.

Consequences and Resolution (1 Samuel 15:24-33)

*Saul's feeble attempt; *Too late for Saul; *Saul's desperate plea.

Warning Sign #6=Saul's pride keeps him from being truly sorry; Lesson=Seek God's glory first.



Conclusion: Separation, Grief, and Regret (1 Samuel 15:34-35)

*A tragic end; *Permanent status of Saul's exile from God's favor; *God's sorrow.

- 1. Paying attention to what God is saying;
- 2. Not allowing disobedience to separate;
- 3. Giving glory to God;
- 4. Prohibiting other voices to rule;

Delighting Your Heart in God means...

5. Surrendering your whole heart to God;
