| August 17, 2025 Series: Wonder: Approaching Faith with Curiosity and Imagination Title: Make Mistakes Text: Luke 22:31–34 : |
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| 1. What's a silly or harmless mistake you made as a kid that you can laugh about now? |
| 2. Who in your life has helped you learn from your mistakes instead of being defined by them? What did they do or say that made a difference? |
| 3. What stood out to you in the message titled, "Wonder: Make Mistakes?" Did a story, phrase or idea help you think differently about failure or faith? |
| 4. Read Luke 22:31-34 aloud. What emotions come up when you hear this passage? How do you imagine Peter felt at this moment? |

| 5. Jesus doesn't stop Peter from failing, but he tells Peter that he's praying for him and believes Peter will return stronger. What does that say about how God sees our mistakes? |
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| 6. Jesus tells Peter, "When you have turned back, strengthen your siblings." How might our own experiences of failure actually equip us to help others? |
| 7. Read John 21:15-19. How does this story of Peter's restoration deepen your understanding of grace and second chances? |
| 8. Read Romans 5:1-5. According to Paul, how can failure or suffering lead to endurance, character and hope? Have you ever experienced that kind of transformation? |
| 9. Is there a mistake (recent or long past) that still causes you to feel shame? What would it look like to bring that to the surface, with God or with someone you trust? |
| 10. How could your group pray for you as you try to embrace grace, learn from your missteps and grow in faith? |
