Series: Summer at the Movies: Harry Potter And the Good News

Title: Living Again (*Deathly Hallows Pt. 2*)

Text: 1 Corinthians 15:50-58

1. If you could instantly revive any forgotten hobby, snack or childhood game, what would you pick? What fun memories come with it?
2. Think of a time when something felt like it was over, a time when you experienced loss, failure, or the end of a season. What came next? Did anything new grow from it?
3. What stood out to you from this week's worship service, "Harry Potter and the Good News: Living Again?" What part of the message felt especially meaningful or surprising?
4. Read 1 Corinthians 15:50–58. Paul says, "Death has been swallowed up in victory." What images or emotions come to mind as you reflect on that?

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5. Paul talks about mystery, transformation, and victory through Christ. How do you understand what it means to “put on” immortality? What might that mean for life now, not just after death?

6. Verse 58 encourages us to “stand firm” and give ourselves fully to God’s work. What helps you stay grounded in your faith when life feels uncertain or fragile?

7. Read Romans 6:4. What does it mean to “walk in newness of life?” How have you experienced a kind of resurrection in your own story, personally, spiritually or relationally?

8. Read John 11:25–26. Jesus says, “I am the resurrection and the life.” How does that promise speak to the places in your life where hope feels hard to grasp?

9. Where in your life, or in the world, do you long to see something “come alive” again? What support, prayer, or next steps might help bring that renewal?

10. How can your group pray for you as you seek to live with resurrection hope this week?

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
