Title: Walk Humbly

Text: Micah 6:6-8

1. When have you been humbled in a funny or surprising way? Share a moment that reminded you not to take yourself too seriously.
2. Who is someone you admire for their humility? What does humility look like in their life?
3. What stood out to you in the message titled, "Wonder: Walk Humbly?" Did a certain phrase, story or image give you a new perspective?
4. Read Micah 6:6-8 aloud. What words or phrases catch your attention? Why do you think this passage is still so often quoted today?

5. The prophet contrasts extravagant religious gestures with doing justice, loving mercy and walking humbly with God. What do you think that says about what God values?

6. What does “walking humbly with God” mean to you in everyday life, at work, in personal relationships, in your faith journey?

7. Read Philippians 2:5-8. How does Jesus’ humility shape our understanding of what it means to walk humbly with God?

8. Read James 3:13-18. What does this passage say about humility and wisdom? How might that challenge our assumptions about leadership or influence?

9. Is there a place in your life right now where humility could help you grow, whether in listening more deeply, letting go of control or asking for help?

10. How can your group pray for you as you seek to walk more humbly with God and with others?
