THE SEASON OF LENT: The Lenten season is a time of preparation leading up to the feast of Easter (the celebration of the resurrection of Jesus). Lent lasts for forty days (excluding Sundays) ending the Saturday before Easter Sunday. It is a time set aside to remember the suffering and death of Jesus and repent of our sins which brought His suffering and death upon Him. Lent reminds us of the necessity of denying ourselves, taking up the cross, and following Jesus but it is not to be a time of moroseness or unbroken sorrow. True repentance leads to joy and rejoicing in God's full and free forgiveness. Thus, Lent is preparation for a feast. Each Sunday during the season of Lent is to be a time of celebration pointing to the reality that we serve a victorious, conquering, and exalted Savior and our repentance and turning away from temptation is for the purpose of preparing us to take part in and rejoice over the victory of Jesus over the world, the flesh, and the devil.
