OFFICER NOMINATIONS: We are again beginning the process to elect new deacons and elders. The elders have opened up a season for receiving nominations running from Sunday, October 19, to Sunday, November 2. The process will be like the procedure we followed in our last election: 1) men will be nominated by members of the congregation (each nominee will require at least 3 members of the congregation to nominate him – nominations should be given to one of the elders); 2) the nominees will be examined by the Session to determine readiness for service; 3) the nominees will go through officer training; 4) and at the end of training, the nominees will be examined by the elders to determine which of the nominees will be placed before the congregation for consideration for the offices of elder and deacon. As always we ask that you pray that the Lord will lead us in choosing those men who are fit and qualified – those whom He has chosen to lead our congregation.




CONFESSION OF SINS:


