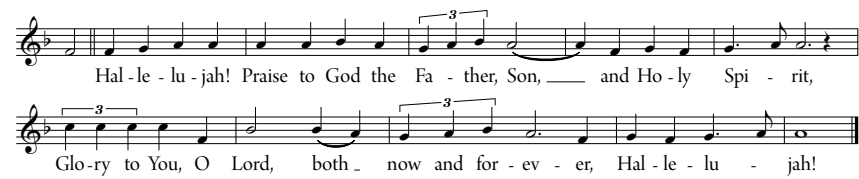
CONFESSION OF SINS:

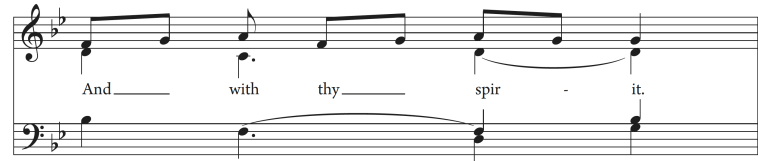
