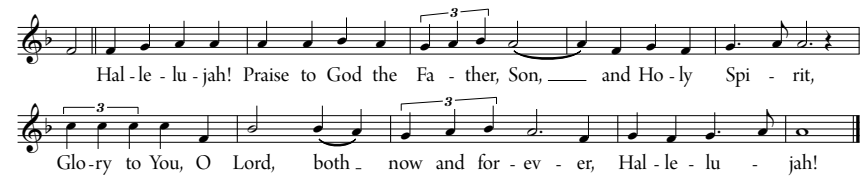
CONFESSION OF SINS:
