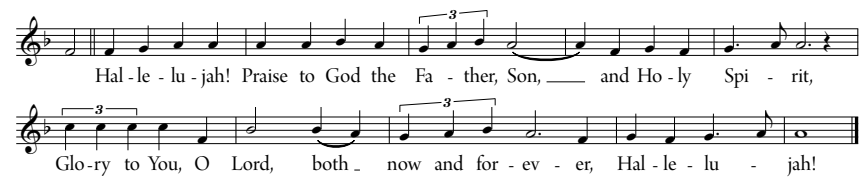
CONFESSION OF SINS:

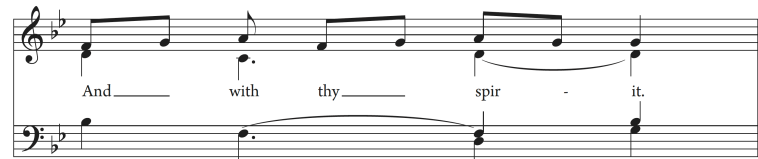

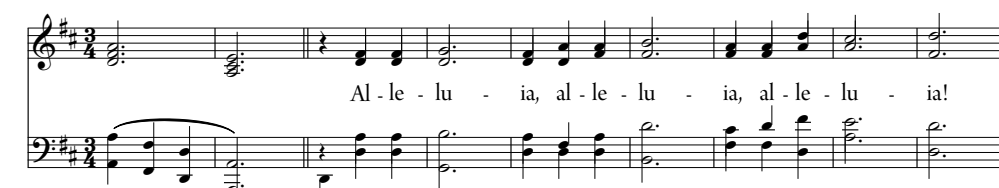
