## THE LORD CLEANSSES US

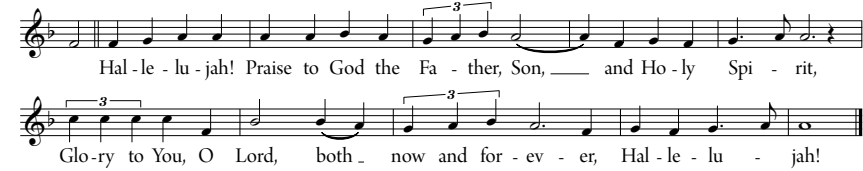
CONFESSION OF SINS:

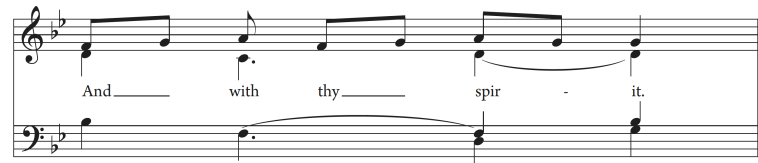

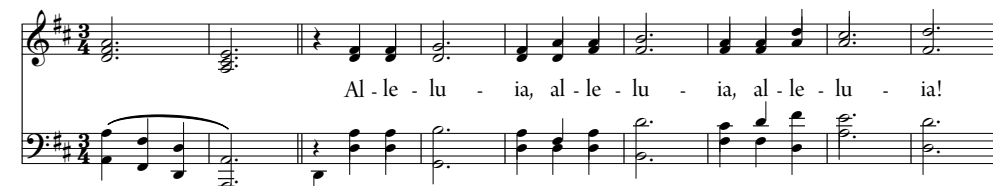
