<sup>22</sup>The crowd joined in the attacks against Paul and Silas, so the authorities ordered that they be stripped of their clothes and beaten with a rod. <sup>23</sup>When Paul and Silas had been severely beaten, the authorities threw them into prison and ordered the jailer to secure them with great care. <sup>24</sup>When he received these instructions, he threw them into the innermost cell and secured their feet in stocks.

<sup>25</sup>Around midnight Paul and Silas were praying and singing hymns to God, and the other prisoners were listening to them. <sup>26</sup>All at once there was such a violent earthquake that it shook the prison's foundations. The doors flew open and everyone's chains came loose. <sup>27</sup>When the jailer awoke and saw the open doors of the prison, he thought the prisoners had escaped, so he drew his sword and was about to kill himself. <sup>28</sup>But Paul shouted loudly, "Don't harm yourself! We're all here!"

<sup>29</sup>The jailer called for some lights, rushed in, and fell trembling before Paul and Silas. <sup>30</sup>He led them outside and asked, "Honorable masters, what must I do to be rescued?" <sup>31</sup>They replied, "Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved—you and your entire household."
