Listen.

"Listen carefully to my words"

God's Word. All of it. How do we listen?
To listen in Hebrew is to not just hear but to

respond.

- Perhaps this is where we struggle. We hear and know much.
- But how are we responding?
- Could we be in danger of becoming "cast sheep"?
 - Sheep need to be rescued. Sometimes they wander and need to be found and sometimes they fall on their backs, this is called a cast sheep.
 - The internet defines older, mature sheep as more susceptible to being a cast sheep. They are fatter (they just take, and take, and take) and have heavy coats with a huge amount of hair. They have too much. Because of that, it's easier for them to trip, stumble, or fall.
- How are we living by listening and thereby responding to what we are learning in God's Word?
- With whom are we sharing what we are learning?

Isaiah 50:4-5 NLT "The Sovereign LORD has

given me his words of wisdom, so that I know how to comfort the weary. Morning by morning he wakens me and opens my understanding to his will. The Sovereign LORD has spoken to me, and I have listened. I have not rebelled or turned away."

- This is a verse that has grabbed me this summer.
- \circ It has become a daily prayer.
- Morning by morning I find He wakens me. Therefore, I need Him to open the understanding to do His will and not my own! And it's about serving each other as we walk along.
- When God speaks will I turn away or will I listen, & respond?
- This is a way I am learning to follow and live like Jesus. Walking, working, watching how Jesus listened and lived.
- What is The Word saying to you lately, how is it impacting how you live, and with whom will you share it?
