-10 more generations from Noah to Adam

-So now we are 20 generations and 2000 years into humanity!

BACK TO THE HALL OF FAITH:

Hebrews 11:8-16 <u>By faith</u> Abraham, when called to go to a place he would later receive as his inheritance, <u>obeyed and went</u>, even though he did not know where he was going.⁹ <u>By</u> <u>faith</u> he <u>made his home in the promised land</u> like a stranger in a foreign country; he lived in tents, as did Isaac and Jacob, who were heirs with him of the same promise. ¹⁰ For he was looking forward to the city with foundations, whose architect and builder is God.

¹¹ And <u>by faith</u> even Sarah, who was past childbearing age, <u>was enabled to bear</u> <u>children</u> because she considered him faithful who had made the promise. ¹² And so from this one man, and he as good as dead, came descendants as numerous as the stars in the sky and as countless as the sand on the seashore.

Hebrews 11:17-19 <u>By faith</u> Abraham, when God tested him<u>, offered Isaac as a</u> <u>sacrifice</u>. He who had embraced the promises was about to sacrifice his one and only son, ¹⁸ even though God had said to him, "It is through Isaac that your offspring will be reckoned." ¹⁹ Abraham reasoned that God could even raise the dead, and so in a manner of speaking he did receive Isaac back from death.

MOVED OUT OF HIS COMFORT ZONE

Genesis 12:1 The Lord had said to Abram, "Go from your country, your people and your father's household <u>to the land I will show you</u>.

Genesis 12:2 "I will make you into a great nation, and I will bless you; <u>I will make your</u> <u>name great, and you will be a blessing.</u>"

Genesis 12:3 "I will bless those who bless you, and whoever curses you I will curse; and all peoples on earth will be blessed through you."

Genesis 12:4-5 <u>So Abram went</u>, <u>as the Lord had told him</u>; and Lot went with him. Abram was seventy-five years old when he set out from Harran. ⁵He took his wife Sarai, his nephew Lot, all the possessions they had accumulated and the people they had acquired in Harran, and they set out for the land of Canaan, <u>and they arrived there</u>.

Genesis 22:1-12 Some time later God tested Abraham. He said to him, "Abraham!"

"Here I am," he replied. ²Then God said, "Take your son, <u>your only son, whom you love—</u> <u>Isaac—</u>and go to the region of Moriah. Sacrifice him there as a burnt offering on a mountain <u>I will show you."</u>

³Early the next morning Abraham got up and loaded his donkey.

He took with him two of his servants and his son Isaac. When he had cut enough wood for the burnt offering, he set out for the place God had told him about. ⁴On the third day Abraham looked up and saw the place in the distance.

⁵He said to his servants, "Stay here with the donkey while I and the boy go over there. We will worship and then <u>we will come back to you."</u>

⁶Abraham took the wood for the burnt offering and placed it on his son Isaac, and he himself carried the fire and the knife. As the two of them went on together,⁷Isaac spoke up and said to his father Abraham, "Father?"

"Yes, my son?" Abraham replied.

"The fire and wood are here," Isaac said, "but where is the lamb for the burnt offering?"

⁸Abraham answered, "<u>God himself will provide the lamb for the burnt offering</u>, my son." And the two of them went on together.

⁹When they reached the place God had told him about, Abraham built an altar there and arranged the wood on it. <u>He bound his son Isaac and laid him on the altar, on top of the wood</u>.

¹⁰ Then he reached out his hand and took the knife to slay his son. ¹¹ But the angel of the Lord called out to him from heaven, "Abraham! Abraham!"

"Here I am," he replied.

¹² "Do not lay a hand on the boy," he said. "Do not do anything to him. Now I know that you fear God, because you have not withheld from me your son, your only son."
