The King of Sodom

¹⁷ After his return from the defeat of Chedorlaomer and the kings who were with him, the king of Sodom went out to meet him at the Valley of Shaveh (that is, the King's Valley).

²¹ And the king of Sodom said to Abram, “Give me the persons, but take the goods for yourself.”

The King of Salem

¹⁸ And Melchizedek king of Salem brought out bread and wine. (He was priest of God Most High.)

7 For this Melchizedek, king of Salem, priest of the Most High God, met Abraham returning from the slaughter of the kings and blessed him, ² and to him Abraham apportioned a tenth part of everything. He is first, by translation of his name, king of righteousness, and then he is also king of Salem, that is, king of peace. ³ He is without father or

mother or genealogy, having neither beginning of days nor end of life, but resembling the Son of God he continues a priest forever.

4 The Lord has sworn

⁴ Then they said, “Come, let us build ourselves a city and a tower with its top in the heavens, and let us make a name for ourselves, lest we be dispersed over the face of the whole earth.” ⁵ And the Lord came down to see the city and the tower, which the children of man had built.
