"The LORD Our Righteousness"

Jeremiah 26:1–6

Righteousness:

*The restoration and renewal of
God's intended design and
purpose for humanity.*

The Problem:
Scattered Sheep (vv. 1–2)

23 *“Woe to the shepherds who destroy and scatter the sheep of my pasture!” declares the Lord. ² Therefore thus says the Lord, the God of Israel, concerning the shepherds who care for my people: “You have scattered my flock and have driven them away, and you have not attended to them. Behold, I will attend to you for your evil deeds, declares the Lord.*

¹⁰ *as it is written:*

“None is righteous, no, not one;

*¹¹ no one understands;
no one seeks for God.*

The Promise:
God Will Gather (vv3-4)

³ Then I will gather the remnant of my flock out of all the countries where I have driven them, and I will bring them back to their fold, and they shall be fruitful and multiply. ⁴ I will set shepherds over them who will care for them, and they shall fear no more, nor be dismayed, neither shall any be missing, declares the Lord.

Jeremiah 23:3–4

The Provision:
The Savior Satisfies (vv3-4)

⁵ “Behold, the days are coming, declares the Lord, when I will raise up for David a righteous Branch, and he shall reign as king and deal wisely, and shall execute justice and righteousness in the land. ⁶ In his days Judah will be saved, and Israel will dwell securely. And this is the name by which he will be called: ‘The Lord is our righteousness.’

Jeremiah 23:5–6

The Great exchange:

*Your sin — placed on Him.
His righteousness — placed on you.*

*You cannot gain righteousness...
you are made righteous
through faith in Christ Jesus*

Questions to Consider:

*Where in your life are you still blaming
others for a condition that started in your
own heart?*

Are you more aware of how others have failed you than how you have failed God?

Where are you waiting to get yourself together before you come to God — as though the gathering depends on your readiness?

Is there a scattered person in your life right now that God may be calling you to reflect His gathering toward?

*Where are you trying to establish your own
righteousness?*

*Where have you stopped trusting in God's
righteousness as being enough?*

*Have you actually received the exchange
— or are you still trying to improve your
own record before you bring it to God?*
