## **Finding God in Life's Chaos: Trusting Him When Nothing Makes Sense**

### **Sermon Summary:**

This sermon addresses how to navigate life's challenges and uncertainties by trusting in God. Pastor Bruce Gordon uses the story of Abram (later Abraham) to illustrate how even in times of confusion and unfulfilled promises, God remains close, caring, and in control. The message emphasizes the importance of seeking God Himself rather than just His blessings, and encourages believers to trust in God's timing and purposes even when circumstances are difficult to understand.

### **Key Points:**

- God is close by and cares about our struggles
- We should seek God Himself, not just His blessings
- God knows all and is never surprised by our circumstances
- Trusting God often means believing Him despite our doubts
- God's promises are certain, even when fulfillment seems impossible
- Faith is about trusting God more than understanding everything
