Questions to Consider

- What does a “blessed” person look like? What does a “wicked” person look like?
- Are you a blessed person or wicked person?

Sermon Points

1. **Verse 1** **Blessed**
To be blessed is not to simply be happy. To be blessed is to be better off inwardly in your heart and soul. To be blessed is have joy when life is good and when life is hard.
2. **Verse 1** **3 Items the Blessed Person Rejects**
 - Wicked Counsel – Teaching, Ideas, Plans and other counsel that is not geared toward the glory of God.
 - Standing in the Way of Sinners – Live the same lifestyle as those who do not love God.
 - Sitting in the Seat of Scoffers – Joining in on unbelief of God.
3. **Verse 2** **2 Items the Blessed Person Receives**
 - Delight in God’s Word – Enjoy and cherish getting in God’s Word to grow in Christ Jesus
 - Meditate on God’s Word – Reviewing and letting God’s Word impact the deepest part of your life.
4. **Verse 3** **The Picture of the Blessed Person**
 - A blessed person has true life and can produce good fruit.
5. **Verse 4** **The Picture of the Wicked Person**
 - In the end, a wicked person, like chaff, is not beneficial for anything.
6. **Verse 5–6** **Results of a Wicked Person**
 - The wicked will not be accepted by God in judgement. They will be cut off from the righteous and die.
