### Questions To Consider

- What type of attitude do you have toward Jesus?
- How should we respond to the truth of Jesus being King and Savior?

### Sermon Points

1. **Verses 1–5 “Laughing at the Lord”**
  - i. The act of mocking/laughing occurs because these individuals do not believe what they have heard about Jesus.
2. **Verse 6 “The Hatred Toward the Lord”**
  - i. Jesus being scourged/flogged was not enough to satisfy their hatred toward Him. They desired to have Jesus killed!
3. **Verse 7–11 “The Authority of the Lord”**
  - i. Pilate’s authority is only because Jesus gave Him that authority. Read John 10:18.
4. **Verse 12–15 “The Signs from the Lord”**
  - i. Pilate had received many signs, 1 being from his wife. He had many opportunities to trust in Jesus.
5. **Verse 15–16 “The Conclusion Toward the Lord”**
  - i. The Jewish leaders and Pilate both refuse to receive Jesus as the Lord and Savior.

### Responding

Do not follow the same path as these people have. Truly trust Jesus as Savior and Lord. Follow Him 24/7 and not just Sunday from 1030-1130am. Respond faithfully to Jesus!
