## Going Further For the week of Jan 28, 2024 Questions and Scriptures for further study

1.	Read 1 Kings 19. What is Jezebel's response to what happened on Mt. Carmel? How does this affect Elijah? Why do you think he responds in this way?
2.	How does God meet Elijah during this time? What are the different ways that God cares for him?
3.	How would you describe Elijah's emotional and spiritual condition as he meets God on Mt. Horeb? What is significant for Elijah to learn when God is not in the wind, earthquake, or fire but instead in a "gentle whisper"? What causes you to miss the "gentle whisper" of God in your own life?
4.	How does God care for Elijah as a whole person (spiritual, emotional, relational, and physical) in this passage? Are there areas of your life that you have neglected? How can you seek the Lord's help to renew you?
<b>Family Devo:</b> Read 1 Kings 19. In this passage God "passes by" Elijah. As God does, there is a mighty wind, an earthquake and a fire. But God was "not in" any of them. Instead, God comes to Elijah in a "gentle whisper." Talk with your kids about how you hear God in your life.
